ORDINANCE 12 OF 1984.

AN ORDINANCE

To AMEND THE COURTS ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Courts (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984 and shall be read as one with the Courts Ordinance as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”).

TO AMEND THE WELLS ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Wells (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984 and shall be read as one with the Wells Ordinance, as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

Section 3
of the principal
Ordinance

2. Section 3 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after subsection (4) thereof the following new subsection to be numbered (5) :—

"(5) A fee of three pounds shall be paid for the issue of a permit to sink or construct a well and a fee of one pound shall be paid for the issue of a copy of such permit."

3. Section 6 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words "five hundred mils" appearing in the first line of subsection (3) thereof and substituting therefor the words "five pounds".
