ORDINANCE 2 OF 1989.

**AN ORDINANCE**

TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO THE IMPORTATION,  
POSSESSION AND USE OF FIREARMS.

**BE** it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Ordinance, 1989 and shall be read as one with the Firearms Ordinance, 1974 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”).

2. Section 22 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended:—

(a) by renumbering the said Section and its proviso as subsection (1); and

(b) by inserting immediately thereafter, the following new subsection to be numbered (2):—

“(2) Any person under the age of 21 years who has in his possession any shot-gun contrary to the provisions of subsection (1) of this Section shall be guilty of an offence under this Ordinance, and shall be liable on conviction to a term of imprisonment not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds or to both such imprisonment and fine and, in the event of a second or subsequent conviction, to a term of imprisonment not exceeding one year or to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to both such imprisonment and fine.”.
