AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DUTIES
ORDINANCE, 1989.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs and Excise Duties (Amendment) Ordinance, 1991 and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise Duties Ordinance, 1989 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”).

2. The Third Schedule to the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting in toto item 6 therein and by renumbering items 7-9 as 6-8 respectively.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE FOREST ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Forest (Amendment) Ordinance, 1991 and shall be read as one with the Forest Ordinance, 1980 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”).

2. Section 23 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (3) thereof, the following new subsection to be numbered (3A) :—

“(3A) In the case of any contravention of the provisions of paragraphs (a), (f) and (g) of subsection (2) hereof and notwithstanding any other measures that may be taken against the offender, the Area Officer may, if the offender is known—

Appendix.

- (a) serve on him a notice in writing which shall be in the form set out in Appendix A to this Ordinance, requiring the removal, demolition, dissolution or dismantling of any structure and the removal of any other article which was either placed or used in the commission of the offences referred to in the said paragraphs, within such period of time as shall in the circumstances be deemed reasonable ;
- (b) on the failure of the offender to comply with any notice in writing served in accordance with paragraph (a) of this subsection, claim against him by a civil action brought in the Judge’s Court, all expenses incurred in effecting the removal, demolition, dissolution, or dismantling of any structure or the removal of any other article which was either placed or used in the commission of an offence.”.
