ORDINANCE 1 OF 1995

AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND THE MOTOR VEHICLES
(THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) ORDINANCE

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1995 and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Ordinance as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance.").

Short title.

Cap.333 (Laws of Cyprus) Ordinances 5/66, 15/87, 8/88, 18/89 and 5/93.

2. Section 15A of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new Section:-

Section 15A of the principal Ordinance repealed and replaced.

15A. Notwithstanding anything in any other Ordinance contained, any action under the provisions of this Ordinance against the tortfeasor, shall be commenced within two years of the date of the accident:

"Limitation of Actions.

Provided that in relation to accidents which occurred before the date of coming into operation of this Ordinance, the period of two years shall be deemed to have commenced on the 28th April, 1993."

**AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION
AND IMPROVEMENT) ORDINANCE**

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1995 and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Ordinance, as amended by the Villages (Administration and Improvement) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1992 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance.").

2. Section 6 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new Section:-

"Constitution of Boards in villages or groups.

6.-(1) There shall be established in every village or group of villages declared to be an improvement area, a Board consisting of the Area Officer as Chairman, the Head of the Community and five members elected in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance and where the Board consists of a group of villages, members of the Board shall be the Head of Community of each village.

(2) The Administrator may at any time by Order increase the number of the elected members.

(3) The term of office of the elected members shall be five years commencing on the 1st January following their election and ending on the 31st December of the fifth year from the commencement of such term of office.

(4) No act or proceeding of the Board shall be deemed to be invalid by reason only of any vacancy in the Board so long as the remaining elected members thereof are not less than three.

(5) If any elected member shall, wilfully and unjustifiably fail to attend at three consecutive meetings of the Board, he shall thereupon become disqualified to sit as a member of the Board and his seat in the Board shall be deemed to be vacated."

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 17th day of April, 1994.
