ORDINANCE 5 OF 1998

AN ORDINANCE
TO PROVIDE FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF
PROSECUTION FOR CERTAIN MINOR OFFENCES
BY PAYMENT OF FIXED PENALTIES

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as The Fixed Penalty Ordinance 1998.

Short title.

2. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires -

Definition.

“fixed penalty” means a penalty prescribed in the first column of the First and Second Schedules in relation to an offence, the payment of which will enable an offender to avoid prosecution for that offence and includes an increase of penalty imposed by paragraph (b) of section 4 of the Ordinance;

“notice” means a notice issued under section 3 of the Ordinance.

3. - (1) If a Police Officer suspects that a person is committing or has committed an offence, the particulars of which are included in the First Schedule or Second Schedule, he may issue and serve on such person a notice in writing giving that person the opportunity of avoiding prosecution in relation to such offence providing he pays a fixed penalty;

Serving of notice

(2) If an Area Officer or any member of his staff authorised by him to act under the provisions of the Ordinance suspects that a person is committing or has committed an offence, the particulars of which are included in the Second Schedule, he may issue and serve on such person a notice in writing giving that person the opportunity of avoiding prosecution in relation to such offence providing he pays a fixed penalty.

4. Where a person is served with a notice under section 3 of the Ordinance -

- (a) no proceedings shall be instituted for that offence within thirty days of the service of the notice;
- (b) the amount payable by way of fixed penalty shall be increased by fifty per centum if not paid within fifteen days of the service of the notice;
- (c) he shall not be convicted of that offence if he pays the fixed penalty including where appropriate any increased penalty as provided in paragraph (b) within thirty days of the service of the notice.

5. A notice served under section 3 of the Ordinance shall give such particulars of the circumstances alleged to constitute the offence as are necessary for giving reasonable information of the offence and shall state -

- (a) the period during which, by virtue of section 4 above, proceedings will not be taken for the offence;
- (b) the amount of the fixed penalty including any increase which may be imposed as a result of non payment within fifteen days;
- (c) the person to whom and the address at which the fixed penalty may be paid.

6. - (1) The person to whom any fixed penalty is paid under the provisions of section 5 of this Ordinance shall issue a receipt in the prescribed form in respect of such payment and in any court proceedings such receipt shall be admissible as evidence of the payment thereof.

(2) Payment of a fixed penalty in accordance with this Ordinance shall not be treated as a conviction in respect of any of the offences the particulars of which are set out in the First and Second Schedules.

7. - (1) Where a Police Officer finds a motor vehicle in relation to which he suspects an offence the particulars of which are included in the First Schedule has been committed, he may affix to the said vehicle a notice issued in accordance with section 3 of the Ordinance.

(2) The affixing of such notice to a motor vehicle shall constitute service of the said notice upon the person suspected to have committed the offence.

(3) For the purposes of this section, there shall be a presumption that the registered owner of the vehicle was the driver or person in charge thereof at the time of the commission of the offence.

8. Any person other than the driver or person in charge of the vehicle, or the registered owner thereof or any person acting with his authority who removes or otherwise tampers with any notice affixed to the said vehicle in accordance with section 7, is guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds.

9. - (1) The Administrator may make Regulations in respect of any matter which is relevant to the implementation of this Ordinance and more particularly with regard to -

Criminal proceedings and increase of fixed penalty after serving of notice.

Evidence of payment.

Affixing of notice on vehicle.

Removal of notice prohibited.

Regulations.

- (a) the form of notice issued under section 3;
 - (b) the duties of Police Officers and Area Officers or members of their staff so authorised by them in relation to the implementation of the provisions of this Ordinance;
 - (c) generally, every matter which needs to be regulated under this Ordinance.
- (2) The Administrator may by order -
- (a) specify those parts of the Sovereign Base Areas to which the Ordinance shall apply;
 - (b) amend the particulars of either of the Schedules;
 - (c) amend the amounts of the fixed penalties for any offence set out in the Schedules, provided that the fixed penalty shall not exceed the maximum amount of fine provided in the legislation creating such offence.
- 10.** The following legislation is repealed -
- (a) the Compounding of Offences Ordinance;
 - (b) section 29 of the Forest Ordinance.
