ORDINANCE 12 OF 2005

AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND THE COURTS ORDINANCE

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Courts (Amendment) Ordinance 2005 and shall be read as one with the Courts Ordinance as amended from time to time (“the principal Ordinance”).

Section 7A of principal Ordinance repealed and replaced.

2. Section 7A of the principal Ordinance is repealed and replaced as follows—

“Associate Judges. **7A.**—(1) Any person who -

- (a) has been qualified to practise as a barrister-at-law, advocate or solicitor in the United Kingdom, or in an equivalent professional capacity in a Court in a part of Her Majesty’s Dominions, or in the Republic of Ireland, for a minimum period of seven years; and
- (b) satisfies the Senior Judge, following consultation with the Resident Judge, that he is a fit and proper person to act,

may be appointed as an Associate Judge.

(2) An Associate Judge shall be appointed by an instrument in writing under the hand of the Administrator and shall hold office for such period and exercise such jurisdiction as the said Instrument shall specify.”
