ORDINANCE 1 OF 2006

AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND THE PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT OF
GAME AND WILD BIRDS ORDINANCE 2004

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Protection and Management of Game and Wild Birds (Amendment) Ordinance 2006.

Short title.

2. For subsection (1) of section 24 of the Protection and Management of Game and Wild Birds Ordinance 2004 (training course and test to be taken for a game licence) there is substituted the following—

Amendment of section 24 of Ordinance 15/2004; amended by Ordinance 22/2005.

“(1) A person shall not—

- (a) shoot, kill, possess, capture or pursue in any manner any game unless he is the holder of a game licence; or
- (b) shoot any game otherwise than with a shot gun.”.

3. For subsection (1) of section 31 of the Protection and Management of Game and Wild Birds Ordinance 2004 (game licence to be conspicuously displayed) there is substituted the following—

Amendment of section 31 of Ordinance 15/2004; amended by Ordinance 22/2005.

“(1) The holder of a game licence shall, at any time—

- (a) when he is hunting; or
- (b) when during the game season he is carrying a shot gun, cartridges, or game in his vehicle,

carry his game licence with him and shall, if he is requested to do so by a game warden or police officer, produce his licence for the game warden’s or police officer’s inspection.”.

4. Schedule X to the Protection and Management of Game and Wild Birds Ordinance 2004 (compounding of offences) is amended as follows—

(a) for the words in the second column (description of offence) relating to the item numbered 3 in the first column, there are substituted the following words—

“Failing to carry a game licence at a time when one is required to be carried or failing to produce a game licence for inspection when required to do so”;

(b) for the words “£25” in the third column (penalty) relating to the item numbered 6 in the first column (unlawful disposal of spent cartridges or other waste) there are substituted the words “£200”.

Commencement.

5. This Ordinance comes into force on the day of its publication in the Gazette.
