QUARANTINE (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 2012

An Ordinance to amend the Quarantine Ordinance.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. Short title and commencement

- (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Quarantine (Amendment) Ordinance 2012.
- (2) This Ordinance comes into force on 1 May 2012.

2. Section 6 (Power to make regulations) of the Quarantine Ordinance amended

Section 6 of the Quarantine Ordinance^(a) is amended by inserting the following additional paragraph after paragraph (g)—

- “(h) creating facilities for the epidemiological surveillance and control of infectious diseases so as to collect, monitor, record and analyse data concerning infectious diseases and to provide information to the Republic and to persons and organisations outside the Island of Cyprus.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the Ordinance)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Quarantine (Amendment) Ordinance 2012 (the “Ordinance”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Ordinance. It does not form part of the Ordinance.
2. The Ordinance mirrors in the Areas the effect of the Republican Quarantine (Amendment) Law 2003 (Law 32(I) 2003). The Ordinance has been amended to permit the Administrator to make Regulations for the epidemiological surveillance and control of infectious diseases.
