**CONTROL (ENTRY, SETTLEMENT AND
COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISES) (AMENDMENT)
(NO. 2) ORDINANCE 2020**

An Ordinance to make provision to amend the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) Ordinance 1960.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

Short title

1.—(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance 2020.

Commencement

2. This Ordinance comes into force on the day after the day on which it is made.

Amendment of the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) Ordinance 1960

3.—(1) The Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) Ordinance 1960(a) is amended as follows.

(2) In section 7 (certain persons to enter freely) after “enter the Areas through an approved port” insert “subject to 7(A)”.

(3) After section 7 insert—

“Power to refuse a person entry to the Areas

7A. For the purpose of preventing or protecting against the incidence or spread of a contagious or infectious disease, a control officer may refuse to allow any person to enter the Areas through an approved port.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) (Amendment)(No. 2) Ordinance 2020 (“the Ordinance”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Ordinance. It does not form part of the Ordinance.

2. The Ordinance amends the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) Ordinance 1960 (“the principal Ordinance”).

3. A new section 7A (powers to refuse a person to enter the Areas) is inserted into the principal Ordinance to provide a power to a control officer to refuse a person to enter the Areas for the purpose of preventing or protecting against the incidence or spread of a contagious or infectious disease.
