(AMENDMENT NO.16) ORDINANCE 2021**

An Ordinance to amend the Protection of Public Health (Covid-19) Ordinance 2021.

**BE** it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

**Short title and commencement**

**1.**—(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Protection of Public Health (Covid-19) (Amendment No.16) Ordinance 2021.

(2) This Ordinance comes into force on 19 June 2021.

**Amendment of the Protection of Public Health (Covid-19) Ordinance 2021**

**2.**—(1) The Protection of Public Health (Covid-19) Ordinance 2021(a) is amended as follows.

(a) Ordinance 2/2021, amended by Ordinances 5/2021, 7/2021, 8/2021, 9/2021, 10/2021, 11/2021, 14/2021, 15/2021, 16/2021, 17/2021, 18/2021, 19/2021, 20/2021, 21/2021 and 22/2021.

(2) In section 13 (measures relating to businesses), in paragraph (b) of subsection (14), for “8” substitute “10”.

(3) In section 22 (catering premises), in paragraph (c) of subsection (1), for “8” substitute “10”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Ordinance)*

1. This explanatory note relates to the Protection of Public Health (Covid-19) (Amendment No.16) Ordinance 2021 ("the Ordinance"). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Ordinance. It does not form part of the Ordinance.
2. The amendments are intended to mirror certain provisions of the Quarantine (Determination of Measures for the Prevention of the Spread of Corona Virus Covid-19) Order (No.25) of 2021 (P.I. 249/2021).
3. Section 2 amends the Protection of Public Health (Covid-19) Ordinance 2021 ("the principal Ordinance").
4. Subsection (2) amends the principal Ordinance to provide that nightclubs may seat 10, rather than 8, people per table.
5. Subsection (3) amends the principal Ordinance to provide that catering premises may seat 10, rather than 8, people per table.
