BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Fixed Penalty (Amendment) Ordinance 2024.

(2) This Ordinance comes into force on 13 February 2024.
