THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS PROTECTION
ORDINANCE

ORDER UNDER SECTIONS 2 AND 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2 and 3 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Ordinance, the Administrator has been pleased to prescribe that the periods specified in the Schedule hereto shall be a close season in addition to the close season as defined in section 2 of the Ordinance.

1. The period between 1st October, 1961, and 21st October, 1961, both days inclusive.
2. The period between the 15th January, 1962, and 31st January, 1962, both days inclusive.

THE INTOXICATING LIQUOR (MANUFACTURE)
ORDINANCE

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 13(1)

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 13(1) of the Intoxicating Liquor (Manufacture) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby orders that the rate of excise duty to be levied and paid upon intoxicating liquor manufactured in the Areas and issued for consumption in the Island of Cyprus shall be seven hundred mils on each gallon of proof spirit contained therein.

(CYPRUS)

ORDER, 1946

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER DEFENCE
REGULATION 64.

P.I. No. 65

(Cyprus)

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, and the Emergency Laws (Transitional Powers) (Colonies, etc.) Order in Council, 1946, (as applied to and adapted in the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia by the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia Order in Council, 1960, and the Laws (Adaptation and Interpretation) Ordinances, 1950 and 1961), the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the First Schedule to this Order, the use, for military purposes, of the land and property specified in the Second Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") during the period of two years from the date of this Order is hereby authorised.

2. The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for such military purposes.

3. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of any interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

FIRST SCHEDULE

1. The land shall be occupied and used for military purposes only.

2. At the expiration of this Order the land shall be returned to the persons entitled thereto free of any erection, structure or construction erected or constructed thereon after the making of this Order.

3. Compensation shall be paid to the persons having an interest in the land for its use and occupation under this Order.

SECOND SCHEDULE

1. The following two areas of land of fifty feet by fifty feet, with everything standing therein and thereon, situated in the Village of Episkopi, in so far as this land falls within the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri, at the Locality of MARATHKAS, being part of Plot No. 132 of the Government Survey Plan LVIII. 5 and part of Plot No. 98 of the Government Survey Plan LVIII. 13. Locality KOURKA, for the purpose of drilling and maintaining two Boreholes; and which land is more particularly defined as the areas coloured Blue on Plan No. 135 signed by the Deputy Assistant Director of Lands, Limassol, and dated 17th August, 1961.

2. An area of land fifteen feet wide situated on plots No. 132 and 98 referred to above for use as Access Tracks to the Boreholes in question for the passage of vehicles and pedestrians, which land is more particularly defined as coloured red on Plan No. 135 referred to above.

THE BREWERIES ORDINANCE

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 13.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 13 of the Breweries Ordinance, the Administrator hereby orders that the rate of excise duty to be levied and paid upon beer manufactured in the Areas shall be one hundred and fifty mils on each gallon:

Provided that there shall be levied and paid upon beer manufactured in the Areas, and delivered to, or on behalf of, the Navy, Army and Air Force Institutes in the Island of Cyprus an excise duty at the special rate of fifty mils on each gallon.
