THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER
DEFENCE REGULATION 63.

Whereas by Order dated the 11th July, 1962, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 13th July, 1962, under Notification No. 24 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), the Administrator has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the second Schedule to the Order, situated in the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months;

And whereas by virtue of Notification No. 2 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 4th January, 1963, the Order was extended for a further period of three months up to the 11th April, 1963;

And whereas the Administrator is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 63, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, (as applied to and adapted in the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia by the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia Order in Council, 1960, and the Laws (Adaptation and Interpretation) Ordinance), which Order continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Ordinance, the Administrator has authorized the use of the said land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order for a further period of six months as from the 12th April, 1963.

And whereas by virtue of Notification No. 1 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 4th January, 1963, the Order was extended for a further period of three months up to the 4th April, 1963;

And whereas the Administrator is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 63, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, (as applied to and adapted in the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia by the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia Order in Council, 1960, and the Laws (Adaptation and Interpretation) Ordinance), which Order continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Ordinance, the Administrator has authorized the use of the said land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order for a further period of six months as from the 5th April, 1963.

THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 226 - Laws of Cyprus).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to Public Instrument No. 3 of 1963, notice is hereby given that the following land is required and the following easements, privileges and liberties are required to be created and acquired for the undertaking of the public utility mentioned therein:—

(i) All those areas of privately-owned land with everything standing thereon, situated in the Village of Kolossi at the Localities:- 'Ayios Nicolas', 'Ayios Stephanos' and 'Phinidji'. Part of Plot Nos. 198/3/1 and 198/3/2 of Government Survey Plan LVIII. 6 and Part of Plot Nos. 10/3, 11 and 89.2 of Government Survey Plan LVIII. 14 comprising 3 evleks 1200 sq. ft. or thereabouts for the purpose of maintaining 4 Boreholes, all which said land is more particularly defined as the area coloured red on Plan No. 190 signed by the Deputy Assistant Director of Lands, Limassol, dated 5th November, 1962.

(ii) Part of Plot No. 109/1 situated at Locality 'Ammo Tepesi', of Government Survey Plan LVIII. 13 comprising 3 Donums 2 Evleks 2500 sq. ft. or thereabouts for the purpose of constructing a Control House and Water Tanks, more particularly defined on Plan 190 referred to above.

(iii) Part of Plot Nos. 336.2, 198/3/1, 198/3/2, 198/1 and 199 situated at Localities 'Ayios Nicolas', 'Ayios Stephanos' and 'Phinidji' of Government Survey Plan LVIII. 6 and Part of Plot Nos. 1/1, 10/1, 10/2, 10/3, 11, 4, 16/1 and 21/1/2 of Government Survey Plan LVIII. 14 comprising an area of 15 ft. in width for the purpose of providing access tracks for the passage of pedestrians and vehicles, more particularly defined as the area coloured green on Plan No. 190 referred to above.

Easements, privileges and liberties for the purpose of laying, using and maintenance of a water pipe line including the provision of manholes and washouts in, over or under the following privately owned lands situated in the Village of Kolossi and Episkopi:—

(a) In the Village of Kolossi:-

Part of Plot Nos. 198/3/1, 198/3/2, 336.1, 336.2 situated at Localities 'Ayios Stephanos', 'Phinidji', 'Vounarkotissa', 'Appis', 'Ammo Tepesi', and 'Stouppoudhia', of Government Survey Plan LVIII. 6 and part of Plot Nos. 11, 10/3, 10/4, 9/3, 9/4, 8, 16/1, 21/1/2, 1/1 (including one manhole) 22/3/1, of Government Survey Plan LVIII. 14 and part of Plot Nos. 109/1, 117/2, 110/1 and 111/1 of Government Survey Plan LVIII. 13.

(b) In the Village of Episkopi:-

Part of Plot Nos. 105/4/4, 105/5/1, 95/1, 92/2, 96/2 and 97/2 situated at Localities 'Stouppoudhia', 'Morlokkos' and 'Kourka' of Government Survey Plan LVIII. 13. Part of Plot Nos. 268.4, 268.3, 142/1/1, 142/2/2, 139/1/1, 139/2/1, 138/1, 136/1 (including one manhole) 135/1, 134/1, 133/1, 132/1, 131/1/2 and 128/2 (including one manhole) situated at localities 'Strongilakas', 'Karavkia', 'Ayia Thekla', 'Stavrosis' and 'Marathkaes' of Government Survey Plan LVIII. 5.

Part of Plot Nos. 93/1, 64/1 (including one manhole) 66, 63, 35/1, 38/1 (including three manholes) 44/1 (including washout and one manhole) 43/1 (including one manhole) 9/1 (including washout and one manhole) 9/2, 5/1/1, 6/1/1, 6/3 and 6/2/1 situated at Localities 'Ayios Armoyenios', 'Tapahanou', 'Turkos Mikros', 'Turkos Megalos' and 'At Meydan'.

2. The route of the said water pipeline is more particularly defined as the line coloured red on Plan 190, signed by the Deputy Assistant Director of Lands, Limassol, dated 5th November, 1962.

3. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands who objects to the acquisition or to the creation and acquisition of the said easements, privileges and liberties, is required within six weeks from the date of the publication of this notice to send me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

4. Her Majesty's Secretary of State for War is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said land, easements, privileges and liberties.

5. The plans mentioned above are available for inspection in my office.

6. P. I. No 4 of 1963 is hereby revoked.
