THE PORT REGULATION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 294 - Laws of Cyprus).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Port Regulation Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following regulations:-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pilotage (Amendment) Regulations 1965 and shall be read as one with the Pilotage Regulations (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended:-

- (a) by deleting paragraph (1) thereof;
- (b) by deleting paragraph (2) thereof and substituting therefor the following new paragraph, to be numbered (1):-

"(1) The fees, to be paid by vessels in respect of pilotage into, or pilotage out of, any port in the Areas, where a pilot is available shall be as follows:-

- (a) For vessels not exceeding 2,000 net registered tons 10 mils per ton.
- (b) For vessels exceeding 2,000 net registered tons but not exceeding 4,000 net registered tons

7 mils for each

additional ton.

10 mils per ton

for the first 2,000

tons.

(c) For vessels exceeding 4,000 net registered tons 10 mils per ton for the first 2,000 tons.

7 mils per ton for the next 2,000 tons.

4 mils for each additional ton exceeding 4,000 tons.

Provided that the fees to be paid by vessels calling for exports only shall be reduced by twentyfive per cent.

Provided further that the minimum fee shall be three pounds.";

SL Vol. I p. 604. (c) by deleting paragraph (3) thereof and substituting therefor the following new paragraph, to be numbered (2):-

"(2) The Fiscal Officer may, with the approval of the Administrator, exempt any vessel from the payment of any of the fees specified in paragraph (1) of this regulation".

THE CUSTOMS MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE

(Cap. 315 - Laws of Cyprus and Ordinances 14 of 1961 and 15 of 1963).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 41.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 41 of the Customs Management Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Management (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) (Amendment) Order 1965, and shall be read as one with the Customs Management (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) Orders 1958 to 1964 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

2. The Third Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new item, to be numbered "7":-

"7. Specialised captive pistols imported and kept in the possession of such competent authorities of slaughter houses in the Island of Cyprus as the Chief Police Officer of the Sovereign Base Areas may approve".

THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 226 - Laws of Cyprusand Ordinances 12 of 1963 and 9 of 1964).

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas by Public Instrument No. 44 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette No. 148 of 4th August, 1965, the Administrator declared the acquisition of certain privatelyowned land for the establishment of a Military Depot at Dhekelia by the Army Department, Ministry of Defence, to be an undertaking of public utility;

And whereas the Area Officer Dhekelia, in compliance with subsection (1) of Section 6 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, by Public Instrument No. 46 of 1965, gave particulars of the land required in connection with the said undertaking of public utility (hereinafter referred to as "the property");

And whereas the Area Officer Dhekelia, in compliance with subsection (2) of the said section, forwarded to the Administrator the required recommendations, plan and particulars;

And whereas the Administrator has approved the plan and particulars submitted, and has considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the property be acquired:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 7 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, the Administrator hereby sanctions the acquisition of the property under the provisions of the said Ordinance.
