**THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC
ORDINANCE**

(Cap. 332 - Laws of Cyprus - and Ordinances 6 of 1961,
15 of 1962, 11 of 1965 and 4 of 1966)

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 7A.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by subsection (1) of section 7A of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Speed Limits Order, 1967.

2. The roads, or parts of roads, set out in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be subject to the respective maximum speed limits set out in the second column in the said Schedule.

3. For the purposes of this Order, the map references shown in the first column of Parts I and II of the Schedule hereto are references to the Town Plans Cyprus Map, Series K 912, Sheet Episkopi Cantonment and Sheet Dhekelia Cantonment, Edition 1 - GSGS, scale 1:5,000.

4. The Speed Limits Order, 1966, and the Speed Limits (Amendment) Order, 1966, are hereby cancelled.

ORDINANCE

(Cap. 332 and 25 of 1959 - Laws of Cyprus - and Ordinances
6 of 1961, 15 of 1962, 11 of 1965 and 4 of 1966)

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (1) (f)

In exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (f) of sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Restriction on Parking) (Amendment) Regulations, 1967, and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles (Restriction on Parking) Regulations 1961, as amended by the Motor Vehicles (Restriction on Parking) (Amendment) Regulations, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”).

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by deleting the Schedule thereto and substituting therefor the following new Schedule:—

(Cap. 83 - Laws of Cyprus - Ordinance 27 of 1961).

AUTHORISATION UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 9 of the Public Roads (Protection) Ordinance, as applied to and adapted in the Areas by the Laws (Adaptation and Interpretation) Ordinance, 1960 to 1962, I, the Chief Officer, Sovereign Base Areas, hereby approve the erection of "no overtaking" signs at the points specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto prohibiting vehicles proceeding in the direction specified in the second column of the said Schedule from overtaking other vehicles proceeding in the same direction from the said points up to the points specified in the third column of the said Schedule.

AUTHORISATION UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 9 of the Public Roads (Protection) Ordinance, as applied to and adapted in the Areas by the Laws (Adaptation and Interpretation) Ordinance, 1960 to 1962, I, the Chief Officer, Sovereign Base Areas, hereby approve the erection of "halt" signs on the roads shown in the first column of the Schedule hereto near to their junctions with the roads shown in the second column of the said Schedule requiring all vehicles emerging from the roads shown in the first column of the said Schedule to halt at the said junctions before proceeding on to the roads shown in the second column of the said Schedule.

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC
ORDINANCE

(Cap. 332 and 25 of 1959 - Laws of Cyprus - and Ordinances
6 of 1961, 15 of 1962, 11 of 1965 and 4 of 1966).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (1) (f).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-paragraph (f) of sub-section (1) of Section 3 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (One-Way Traffic) Regulations, 1967.

2. In these Regulations—

“one-way street” means any road or place whereon the direction of the flow of traffic is specified;

“vehicle” means any mechanically propelled vehicle and shall include tractors, bicycles, tricycles and any other vehicle, carriage or cart drawn by an animal and any trailer attached to any vehicle.

3. The roads or parts of roads set out in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be one-way streets.

4. No person shall drive a vehicle in the one-way streets set out in the first column of the Schedule hereto except in the direction set out in the second column of the said Schedule.

5. Any person who drives a vehicle in contravention of Regulation 4 of these Regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to imprisonment not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds or to both such imprisonment and fine.

THE EXCHANGE CONTROL ORDINANCE
(Cap. 199 - Laws of Cyprus)

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTIONS 4 (1) AND 19 (1).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Sections 4 (1) and 19 (1) of the Exchange Control Ordinance, the Fiscal Officer hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Exchange Control (Specified Currency and Prescribed Securities) Order, 1967.
2. All foreign currency is hereby specified as foreign currency for which section 4 of the Exchange Control Ordinance shall apply.
3. The provisions of section 19 of the Exchange Control Ordinance shall apply to securities on which capital moneys, dividends or interest are payable in foreign currency or in cases where the holder has an option to require payment of any capital moneys, dividends or interest thereon in foreign currency.
4. The Exchange Control (Specified Currency) Order, 1965 and the Exchange Control (Prescribed Securities) Order, 1954 are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The effect of this Order is to extend the meaning of "specified currency" to all currencies other than sterling.

THE WELLS ORDINANCE

(Cap. 351 - Laws of Cyprus).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 4(2).

Whereas the Administrator, being satisfied that special measures for the conservation of water in the area set out in the Schedule hereto are necessary in the public interest, proposes to make an Order in respect of such area under section 4 of the Wells Ordinance:

Now, therefore, by the direction of the Administrator notice is hereby given that the particulars of the proposed Order shall be as set out in the Schedule hereto and that a copy of the draft of the proposed Order and every relevant map and plan may be inspected at the Area Office Akrotiri during office hours and free of charge during a period of fourteen days of the publication of this notice in the Gazette and that any person may, within the same period, by notice addressed to the Area Officer Akrotiri object to the making of the Order.

SCHEDULE

DEFINED AREA.

In the villages of Paramali and Evdhimou, in so far as they lie within the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri, the area within the following boundary, that is to say:—

The boundary commences at the most northern point of plot No. 96 of the Survey Plan No. LII.64, which point is on the Limassol - Paphos main road and proceeds in an easterly direction along the said main road to the Paramali village road; thence in a north - easterly direction along the said village road to the most northern point of plot No. 89 of the Survey Plan No. LIII.57; thence south - eastwards in a straight line to the most southern point of plot No. 75 of the said Plan, which point is on a road; thence in a southerly direction along the said road to the said main road; thence westwards along the said main road to the point due north of the north - eastern corner of plot No. 142 of the said plan, which corner is on a footpath; thence due south to the said corner on the said footpath; thence in a south - easterly direction along

the said footpath to the north - eastern corner of plot No. 111 of the Survey Plan No. LVIII.1; thence south - westwards in a straight line to the south - eastern corner of plot No. 122 of the said Plan; thence due south in a straight line to the sea - shore; thence in a westerly and south - westerly direction along the said sea - shore to the village boundary between the villages of Evdhimou and Paramali; thence in a north - easterly direction along the said village boundary to the point where it is cut by the road leading to the said main road; thence in a northerly direction along the said road to the point of commencement, all which said boundary is shown edged red on the Survey Plan Serial No. 2022.

THE COMMODITIES AND SERVICES
(REGULATION AND CONTROL) ORDINANCE.

(Ordinances 11 of 1962, 9 of 1963 and 3 of 1967).

CONTROL ORDER UNDER SECTION 3 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Section 3 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Perishable Goods) (Control and Fixing of Profit) (Amendment) Order, 1967 and shall be read as one with the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Perishable Goods) (Control and Fixing of Profit) Order, 1967 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

2. The principal Order is hereby amended:—

(a) by adding the following proviso at the end of paragraph 4 thereof:—

“Provided that in cases where the said maximum percentage profit in respect of items 1, 2 and 5 (artichokes, cucumbers and marrows) specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto is less than ten mils per oke, a profit of not more than ten mils per oke may be derived from the sale by retail thereof.”;

(b) by inserting in the first and second columns of the Schedule thereto, respectively:—

(i) in the part of the said Schedule to the principal Order headed “Vegetables” immediately after item 13 thereof the items of vegetables and maximum percentage profit set out in the first and second columns respectively of the First Part of the Schedule to this Order; and

(ii) in the part of the said Schedule to the principal Order headed “Fruit” immediately after item 29 (renumbered as item 34) thereof the items of fruit and maximum percentage profit set out in the first and second columns respectively of the Second Part of the Schedule to this Order;

(c) by renumbering items 14 to 29 inclusive thereof as items 19 to 34 inclusive, respectively; and

(d) by renumbering item 30 thereof as item 44.
