THE WELLS ORDINANCE  
(Cap. 351 - Laws of Cyprus).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 4(2).

Whereas the Administrator, being satisfied that special measures for the conservation of water in the area set out in the Schedule hereto are necessary in the public interest, proposes to make an Order in respect of such area under Section 4 of the Wells Ordinance:

Now, therefore, by the direction of the Administrator notice is hereby given that the particulars of the proposed Order shall be set out in the Schedule hereto and that a copy of the draft of the proposed Order and every relevant map and plan may be inspected at the Area Office, Dhekelia, during office hours and free of charge during a period of fourteen days of the publication of this notice in the Gazette and that any person may, within the same period, by notice addressed to the Area Officer, Dhekelia, object to the making of the Order.

**SCHEDULE**

DEFINED AREA.

In the village of Pergamos, within the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia, the area within the following boundary, that is to say:—

The boundary commences at the point where the old boundary of Larnaca and Famagusta Districts crosses the boundary of the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia on the Survey Plan No. XXXII. 42, and proceeds in an easterly direction to the point where the boundary in question crosses the main Pergamos-Lefkoniko road; thence in a southerly direction along the said main road up to the 11th Mile Post along that road; thence westwards, in a straight line, to a point on the boundary of the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia 95 feet south of Boundary Pillar 53; thence northwards along the said boundary to Boundary Pillar 53; thence further northwards to the point of commencement, all which said boundary is shown edged red on the Survey Plan Serial No. 2029.
