THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS PROTECTION  
ORDINANCE

ORDER UNDER SECTION 5A.

---

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 5A of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Ordinance, I, the Chief Officer, hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Game and Wild Birds Protection (Maximum Number of Game Shot) Order, 1967.
  2. The number of game that may be shot by the holder of a game licence on any one day shall not exceed one hare and six partridges or one hare, five partridges and one francolin.

THE ANNUAL HOLIDAYS WITH PAY  
ORDINANCE, 1967

(Ordinance No. 7 of 1967).

---

HOLIDAY REGISTER ORDER, 1967.

---

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 15 of the Annual Holidays with Pay Ordinance, 1967, the Chief Officer, Sovereign Base Areas, hereby prescribes the manner and form of the Holiday Register required to be kept by employers.

The Holiday Register, containing all the particulars set out in the Schedule hereto, shall be kept in the form of a book, or in loose leaves bound up in a binder, or in such other form as may suit the employer's organisation of his business, provided that it is in such a form as to be immediately available for inspection by any Inspector.

**SCHEDULE**

The employer, as soon as an employee enters his employment, shall record in the Holiday Register the following particulars:—

- (a) the name, age and sex of the employee;
  - (b) the identity card number and the insurance card number of the employee;
  - (c) the date on which the employee entered his employment;
  - (d) the date the employee left his employment;
  - (e) each week the wage or salary paid to the employee, any amount paid as overtime or by way of commission, if any, and the value of the stamps affixed in the employee's holiday booklet;
  - (f) the date and length of the holiday given to the employee for each leave year of service.

(Cap. 351 - Laws of Cyprus).

## NOTICE UNDER SECTION 4 (2).

Whereas the Administrator, being satisfied that special measures for the conservation of water in the area set out in the Schedule hereto are necessary in the public interest, proposes to make an Order in respect of such area under Section 4 of the Wells Ordinance:

Now, therefore, by the direction of the Administrator notice is hereby given that the particulars of the proposed Order shall be set out in the Schedule hereto and that a copy of the draft of the proposed Order and every relevant map and plan may be inspected at the Area Office, Dhekelia, during office hours and free of charge during a period of fourteen days of the publication of this notice in the Gazette and that any person may, within the same period, by notice addressed to the Area Officer, Dhekelia, object to the making of the Order.

## SCHEDULE

The boundary commences at the point where the boundary of the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia crosses the old boundary of the Larnaca and Famagusta Districts on the Survey Plan No. XXXII. 42, and proceeds in a northerly direction along the boundary of the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia, up to the point where the boundary in question crosses the main Pergamos-Lefkoniko road; thence in a southerly direction along the said main road, to a point where this road crosses the old boundary of the Larnaca and Famagusta Districts; thence in a westerly direction along the old boundary of Larnaca and Famagusta Districts to the point of commencement, all which said boundary is shown edged red on the Survey Plan Serial No. 2018.

**THE WELLS ORDINANCE**

ORDER BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4 of the Wells Ordinance, the Administrator hereby defines for the purposes of the said section the area set out in the Schedule hereto as an area in which no permit for the sinking or construction of a well shall be issued and no variations or modification of any condition or restriction imposed on any such permit shall be effected, save with the concurrence of the Chief Officer, in accordance with the provisions of the said section.

The boundary commences at the point where the old boundary of Larnaca and Famagusta Districts crosses the boundary of the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia on the Survey Plan No. XXXII.42, and proceeds in an easterly direction to the point where the boundary in question crosses the main Pergamos-Lefkoniko road; thence in a southerly direction along the said main road up to the 11th Mile Post along that road; thence westwards, in a straight line, to a point on the boundary of the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia 95 feet south of Boundary Pillar 53; thence northwards along the said boundary to Boundary Pillar 53; thence further northwards to the point of commencement, all which said boundary is shown edged red on the Survey Plan Serial No. 2029.

THE POLICE ORDINANCE, 1967  
(Ordinance No. 9 of 1967).

---

DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 25(3).

---

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (3) of Section 25 of the Police Ordinance, 1967, the Administrator has been pleased to direct that the proceeds of the sale of any unclaimed property sold under the provisions of the said section shall, if no claim to such property has been established within the period mentioned in the said section and after the deduction of any expenses incurred by such sale, be disposed of as follows:—

- (a) fifty **per centum** of the proceeds shall be paid into the Sovereign Base Areas Administration public account;
- (b) twenty-five **per centum** of the proceeds shall be paid into the Police Fines and Rewards Fund;
- (c) twenty-five **per centum** of the proceeds shall be paid to the finder of the property in question:

Provided that if such finder is a member of the Force the said twenty-five **per centum** of the proceeds shall also be paid into the Police Fines and Rewards Fund.

The Direction of the Governor of the Colony in Public Instrument No. 285 of 1958 is hereby revoked.
