**THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
PROTECTION ORDINANCE**

(Cap. 65 - Laws of Cyprus - and Ordinances 19 of 1961,
17 of 1962, 19 of 1964 and 6 of 1966).

GAME RESERVE AREAS ORDER.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 19 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Ordinance, the Administrator hereby declares the areas specified in the Schedule hereto to be a Game Reserve.

2. P.I. No. 25/67 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 21st March 1967 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

GAME RESERVE AREA "A"

All that area of land and Limassol Salt Lake marshes comprised within the following boundaries:—

The area commences at Forest Cairn 40 of the Akrotiri Main State Forest; thence to Forest Cairn 41; thence southwards in a straight line across the Salt Lake to the road leading to Ayios Nicolaos church; thence in a westerly direction to Forest Cairn 1; thence along the eastern side of the Akrotiri - Phassouri road up to Forest Cairn 31; thence northeast in a straight line to Forest Cairn 37; thence in an easterly direction along Forest Cairns 38 and 39 to the point of commencement, all which area is marked on the ground by appropriate sign boards and is more particularly shown on a map marked "Limassol Salt Lake Game Reserve" and kept at the Headquarters of the Sovereign Base Areas Administration.

GAME RESERVE AREA "B"

All that area of land north of the Royal Air Force Station Akrotiri comprised within the following boundaries:—

The area commences at point 'A' on the perimeter fence of the Royal Air Force Station Akrotiri and runs in a northerly direction along the western edge of the citrus and vine plantations of the See of Kitium up to the road leading to Ayios Nicolaos church; thence along the said road in an easterly direction up to the edge of the said plantations; thence across the said road in a north easterly direction along the northern edge of the said plantations to point 'B'; thence it runs in a southerly direction in a straight line to point 'C' on a road leading from the Bishop's residence to Ladies Mile beach; thence along the said road and along the northern edge of the said plantations up to point 'D'; thence in a north easterly direction along the edge of the said plantations and in a straight line to point 'E' on the beach; thence along the

beach to the south to the perimeter fence of the Royal Air Force Station and thence along the said fence to the point of commencement; all which area is more particularly shown on a map marked "Akrotiri Game Reserve" and kept at the Headquarters of the Sovereign Base Areas Administration and marked on the ground by appropriate sign boards:

Provided that the main road from Akrotiri village to Ladies Mile coloured blue on the said map shall be excluded from the Game Reserve.
