THE VINE INDUSTRY (REGULATION AND
CONTROL) ORDINANCE

(No. 10 of 1965).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 5.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 5 of the Vine Industry (Regulation and Control) Ordinance and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Short title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Planting of Vines (Regulation and Control) Regulations, 1969.

Application
for approval
for planting
of vines.

2.—(1) Any person who intends to plant vines shall apply to the Commission for approval thereof.

(2) The applicant shall supply all relevant information by completing Form 1 of the Schedule hereto and shall supply in writing any other relevant information which the Commission may require.

(3) The Commission may grant approval under the provisions of this regulation subject to any conditions considered necessary in the public interest or for the purpose of protecting, promoting and improving the vine industry, and, without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, may impose conditions in relation to:—

- (a) the extent of land to be planted up;
- (b) the type of variety of vine plants;
- (c) the number of plants per donum;
- (d) the method of planting.

(4) Any approval granted by the Commission shall be issued in the manner specified in Form 2 of the Schedule hereto.

(5) Any person to whom approval has been granted under the provisions of these regulations subject to any conditions shall, not later than thirty days from the completion of planting, notify the Commission who, if satisfied that the conditions or any part thereof have been carried out, shall make a note to this effect on the form of approval issued.

(6) No person shall occupy or use, or cause or allow any other person to occupy or use any land on which vines have been planted following approval by the Commission unless the Commission has endorsed on the form of approval issued in respect of such planting that the conditions contained therein have been carried out.

Offences
and penalties.

3. Any person who—

- (a) without approval from the Commission plants any vines or causes or suffers or allows such planting; or
- (b) acts in contravention of any condition attached to such approval or takes any action contrary to such condition; or
- (c) fails to comply with the provisions of paragraphs (5) or (6) of regulation 2 of these Regulations,

shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to imprisonment not exceeding three months or a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to both such imprisonment and fine.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 3 of the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) Ordinance, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Amendment) Order, 1969, and shall be read as one with the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) Order, as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

CHANGE OF TITLES ORDINANCE

(Cap. 40 - Laws of Cyprus).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 3 of the Change of Titles Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Change of Titles (Registrars) Order, 1969 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of April, 1969.

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Senior Registrar”, “Registrar” or “Assistant Registrar” mean the Senior Registrar or Registrar, or the former Registrar or former Assistant Registrar, as the case may be, of both the Senior Judge’s Court and the Judge’s Court of the Sovereign Base Areas.

3. From the date of the coming into operation of this Order the title of Registrar is hereby changed to Senior Registrar, and the title of Assistant Registrar is hereby changed to Registrar, and the new titles shall be substituted for the old titles wherever they appear in any enactment or in any official book or document.

THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) ORDINANCE

(Cap. 28 - Laws of Cyprus).

THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT)
REGULATIONS, 1956 to 1959.

NOTICE UNDER REGULATIONS 20(h) AND 53(2).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Regulations 20(h) and 53(2) of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Regulations, 1956 to 1959, I hereby make declarations in manner following:—

- (a) grapes of the 1969 crop, intended for export as table grapes, shall be required before being harvested to be inspected at the place where they are grown, by an Inspector; and shall be selectively picked;
- (b) the minimum requirements of maturity of sultana grapes shall be 9 degrees Baumé except where in the opinion of the Inspector other factors affect maturity.
