THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER
DEFENCE REGULATION 63.

Whereas by Order dated the 10th October, 1961, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 11th October, 1961, under Notification No. 50 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), the Administrator has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of two years;

And whereas by virtue of Notification No. 50 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 24th September, 1963, the Order was extended for a further period of two years;

And whereas by virtue of Notification No. 54 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 4th September, 1965, the Order was extended for a further period of one year;

And whereas by virtue of Notification No. 43 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 16th September, 1966, the Order was extended for a further period of one year;

And whereas by virtue of Notification No. 78 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 6th October, 1967, the Order was extended for a further period of two years;

And whereas the Administrator is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of two years:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 63, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which Order continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Ordinance, the Administrator has authorised the use of the said land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order for a further period of two years as from the 9th October, 1969.

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER
DEFENCE REGULATION 63.

Whereas by Order dated the 11th July, 1962, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 13th July, 1962, under Notification No. 24 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), the Administrator has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months;

And whereas by virtue of Notification No. 2 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 4th January, 1963, the Order was extended for a further period of three months up to the 11th April, 1963;

And whereas by virtue of Notification No. 14 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 3rd April, 1963, the Order was extended for a further period of six months up to the 10th October, 1963;

And whereas by virtue of Notification No. 51 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 24th September, 1963, the Order was extended for a further period of two years;

And whereas by virtue of Notification No. 55 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 4th September, 1965, the Order was extended for a further period of one year;

And whereas by virtue of Notification No. 44 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 16th September, 1966, the Order was extended for a further period of one year;

And whereas by virtue of Notification No. 79 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 6th October, 1967, the Order was extended for a further period of two years;

And whereas the Administrator is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of two years;

**THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS PROTECTION
ORDINANCE**

(Cap. 65 - Laws of Cyprus - and Ordinances 19 of 1961,
17 of 1962, 19 of 1964 and 6 of 1966)

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTIONS 2 AND 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2 and 3 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Ordinance, the Administrator has prescribed that the periods specified in the Schedule hereto shall be a close season in addition to the close season as defined in section 2 of the Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

- a. The period between 1st October 1969 and 1st November 1969, both days inclusive.
- b. The period between 12th January 1970 and 31st January 1970, both days inclusive.
- c. All days in the week during a non-close season except Wednesdays and Sundays.

REGULATIONS, 1956 to 1959.

NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 20 (d).
