THE COMMODITIES AND SERVICES
(REGULATION AND CONTROL) ORDINANCE
(Ordinances 11 of 1962, 9 of 1963 and 3 of 1967).

CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER
MADE UNDER SECTIONS 3(1) AND 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Potatoes) Order 1969.

2. In this Order—

“potatoes” means potatoes declared to be a controlled commodity under the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Percentage of Profit) (Perishable Goods) Order, 1969.

3. The maximum price at which potatoes may be sold by retail in the Areas shall not exceed seventy-five (75) mils per oke.

4. The Schedule to the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Percentage of Profit) (Perishable Goods) Order, 1969 is hereby amended by deleting Item 11 thereof relating to potatoes.

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
PROTECTION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 65 - Laws of Cyprus and Ordinances 19 of
1961, 17 of 1962, 19 of 1964 and 6 of 1966).

ORDER UNDER SECTION 5A.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 5A of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Ordinance, I, the Chief Officer, hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Game and Wild Birds Protection (Maximum Number of Game Shot) Order, 1969.

2. The number of game that may be shot by the holder of a game licence on any one day shall not exceed two hares and six partridges or two hares, four partridges and two francolins.
