THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT)
REGULATIONS, 1956 to 1959.

NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 20 (d).

THE POLICE ORDINANCE
(Ordinances 9 of 1967 and 14 of 1969).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Section 9 of the Police Ordinance, I, the Chief Police Officer, with the approval of the Administrator, hereby make the following Regulations:-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (General) (Amendment No.2) Regulations, 1969, and shall be read as one with the Police (General) Regulations, 1967 to 1969 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by deleting the First Schedule thereto and substituting therefor the following:-

"FIRST SCHEDULE

(Regulation 11).

3. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1969.

**THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
PROTECTION ORDINANCE**

(Cap. 65 - Laws of Cyprus and Ordinances 19 of
1961, 17 of 1962, 19 of 1964 and 6 of 1966).

GAME RESERVE AREA ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 19 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Ordinance, the Administrator hereby declares the area specified in the Schedule hereto to be a Game Reserve.

SCHEDULE

GAME RESERVE AREA

All that area of land comprised within the following boundaries:—

The area commences at Boundary Pillar No. 1 of the Dhekelia Sovereign Base Area; thence northwards along the Sovereign Base Area boundaries to the junction of Pergamos road and Anzio Camp; thence in a straight line in a southeasterly direction to the junction of Larnaca-Famagusta road and Xylotymbou road; thence eastwards in a straight line to the administrative boundary between Xylotymbou and Ormidhia villages; thence in a straight line southwards to the sea east of the Water Distillation Plant; thence along the beach in a westerly direction to the point of commencement, all which area is marked on the ground by appropriate sign boards and is more particularly shown on a map marked Dhekelia Game Reserve and kept at the Sovereign Base Areas Administration Office, Dhekelia.

THE SALE OF FOOD AND DRUGS ORDINANCE
(Cap. 261-Laws of Cyprus-and Ordinance No. 8 of 1967).

REFULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 19.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 19 of the Sale of Food and Drugs Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Cyclamic Acid (Prohibition in Food) Regulations, 1969.

2. In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires—

“cyclamic acid” means cycloexylsulphamic acid and includes its sodium, potassium or calcium salts.

3.—(1) No article of food prepared in the Island of Cyprus and offered for sale in the Areas for human consumption shall contain cyclamic acid.

(2) No article of food containing cyclamic acid shall be—

- (a) imported;
- (b) sold, possessed, exposed or offered for sale;
- (c) despatched or delivered

in the Areas.

(3) No cyclamic acid shall, in the Areas, be sold or possessed or offered or advertised for sale (whether such sale is to take place in the Areas or elsewhere) or stored for the purpose of being used in the Areas or elsewhere in the preparation of any article of food for human consumption.

(4) Nothing in these Regulations shall affect or shall be deemed to affect stocks of articles of food which, the Chief Officer is satisfied, were imported or manufactured in the Island of Cyprus prior to the publication of these Regulations, provided that such stocks shall be sold or otherwise disposed of by—

- (a) 1st December, 1969, in respect of soft drinks manufactured in the Island of Cyprus; and
- (b) 1st February, 1970, in respect of any other article of food.
