THE MOTOR VEHICLES REGULATIONS, 1959 to 1967.

APPOINTMENT OF PERSONS TO EXERCISE POWERS
UNDER REGULATION 63.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Registrar of Motor Vehicles by Regulation 63 of the Motor Vehicles Regulations, I, the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, hereby appoint the person whose name is set out in the Schedule hereto to exercise the powers exercisable by persons appointed by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles under the provisions of the said Regulation.

THE POLICE ORDINANCE

(Ordinances 9 of 1967 and 14 of 1969.)

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Section 9 of the Police Ordinance, I, the Chief Police Officer, with the approval of the Administrator, hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (General) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations, 1969 and shall be read as one with the Police (General) Regulations, 1967, as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”).

2. Regulation 26 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended:

(a) by deleting the figure “3.75%” appearing in sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) thereof and substituting therefor the figure “3%”;

(b) by deleting sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (1) and substituting therefor the following new sub-paragraph:

“(c) resides either by himself or with his wife or any member of his family, for whose maintenance he is responsible, in a house or flat owned by him or his wife or such other member of his family in respect of which the rental of a comparable house or flat in the same locality exceeds 3% of his basic salary (hereinafter called “notional rent”)

shall be eligible for assistance from the Administration in the form of rent allowance:”;

(c) by deleting item (ii) of the proviso to sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (1) thereof and substituting therefor the following new item:

“(ii) rent allowance shall in no case exceed the following limits:

BASIC SALARY	ALLOWANCES
Up to £ 760	28% of basic salary (maximum £ 210 p.a.)
Over £ 760 to £ 1,040	28% of basic salary (maximum £ 220 p.a.)
Over £ 1,040	20% of basic salary”.

3. Regulation 27 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended:

(a) by deleting the figure and words “3.75 per centum” appearing therein and substituting therefor the figure and words “3 per centum”; and

- (b) by deleting the figure and words "5 per centum" appearing therein and substituting therefor the figure and words "4 per centum".

4. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by deleting the second Schedule thereto and substituting therefor the following new Schedule:

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1970, provided that:

- (i) paragraphs (a) and (c) of Regulation 2 and Regulation 3 of these Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January, 1968; and
- (ii) Regulation 4 of these Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st May, 1969.

**THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
PROTECTION ORDINANCE**

(Cap. 65 - Laws of Cyprus and Ordinances 19 of 1961,
17 of 1962, 19 of 1964 and 6 of 1966.)

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 7.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Administrator under Section 7 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Ordinance, the Administrator hereby orders that the shooting, killing, taking, pursuing or selling of partridges and francolins for the period 28th December, 1969 to 12th January, 1970, both dates inclusive, is prohibited.

THE PRISON DISCIPLINE ORDINANCE

(Cap. 286 - Laws of Cyprus.)

NOTICE ISSUED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him under Section 2 of the Prison Discipline Ordinance, the Administrator has directed that all Royal Air Force and military hospitals and other places within the Sovereign Bases controlled by Her Majesty's Services in which persons may be given medical treatment shall be set apart as prisons for the purposes of medical treatment or examination of persons committed to prison in the Sovereign Base Areas.
