THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ORDINANCE 1969

(Ordinance 12 of 1969).

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR
UNDER SECTION 129 (2).

In exercise of the powers vested in him under subsection (2) of Section 129 of the Customs and Excise Ordinance 1969, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Marketing and Sale of Manufactured Tobacco Licensing) Order, 1970.

2. In this Order—

“licence” means a licence for the marketing or sale of manufactured tobacco issued under subsection (1) of Section 129 of the Ordinance ;

“marketing” means offering or exhibiting for sale.

3. Every licence shall be issued by the Fiscal Officer in the form set out in the Schedule to this Order and shall be personal to the applicant :

Provided that if a licensee shall die during the continuance of the licence the Fiscal Officer may at the request of his heirs or any of them transfer such licence to any one of the heirs and the licence so transferred shall remain in force for the remaining period of validity of the licence of the deceased.
