ORDINANCE

(Cap. 65—Laws of Cyprus and Ordinances  
19 of 1961, 17 of 1962, 19 of 1964 and 6 of 1966).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTIONS 2 AND 3.

---

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2 and 3 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Ordinance, the Administrator has prescribed that the periods specified in the Schedule hereto shall be a close season in addition to the close season as defined in section 2 of the Ordinance.

**SCHEDULE**

- (a) The period between 1st October, 1973 and 8th December, 1973, both days inclusive.
  - (b) The period between 24th December, 1973 and 31st January, 1974, both days inclusive.
  - (c) All days in the week during a non - close season except Sundays.

CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER MADE  
UNDER SECTIONS 3 (1) AND 4 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Administrator by sub-section (1) of sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Fresh Pork) Order, 1973.

2. In this Order—

“fresh pork” means the fresh meat of pigs reared in the Island of Cyprus, whether offered for sale unslaughtered or as carcass;

“maximum price” means the price specified in the second column of the Schedule hereto.

3. Fresh pork is hereby declared to be a controlled commodity for the purpose of the Ordinance.

4. The price at which fresh pork may be sold or offered for sale in the Areas, shall not exceed the maximum price.

5. Public Instrument No. 23 of 1968 is hereby revoked.

CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER MADE  
UNDER SECTIONS 3 (1) AND 4 (1).

---

In exercise of the powers vested in the Administrator by subsection (1) of sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Fresh Beef, Mutton, Goat Meat and Chickens) Order, 1973.

2. In this Order—

“fresh beef, mutton, goat meat and chickens” means the fresh meat of cattle, sheep, goats and chickens reared in the Island of Cyprus ;

“maximum price” means the price specified in the second column of the Schedule hereto.

3. Fresh beef, mutton, goat meat and chickens are hereby declared to be controlled commodities for the purpose of the Ordinance.

4. The price at which fresh beef, mutton, goat meat and chickens may be sold or offered for sale in the Areas, shall not exceed the maximum price.

5. Public Instrument Nos. 7 of 1972 and 18 of 1972 are hereby revoked.
