THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL
POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER DEFENCE
REGULATION 63.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 63, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, (as applied to and adapted in the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia by the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia Order in Council, 1960 and the Laws (Adaptation and Interpretation) (Consolidation and Extension) Ordinance, 1968) which Order continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:—

1. Subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the First Schedule to this Order, the use, for the purpose of setting up a refugee camp, of the land and property specified in the Second Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") during a period of two months from the date of this Order is hereby authorised.

2. The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for the purposes referred to in paragraph 1.

3. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person whether by virtue of any interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

4. Public Instrument No. 35 of 1974 is hereby revoked.

FIRST SCHEDULE

1. The land shall be occupied and used for the purpose of setting up a refugee camp only.

2. At the expiration of this Order the land shall be returned to the persons entitled thereto free of any erection, structure or construction erected or constructed thereon after the making of this Order.

3. Compensation shall be paid to the persons having an interest in the land for its use and occupation under this Order.

SECOND SCHEDULE

An area of land embracing part of plots 26, 30, 31, 33, 34 and 40 and the whole of plots 32 and 51 of the Government Survey Sheet/Plan No. LIII/57 situated at Paramali village within the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area and shown on a plan kept at the Headquarters of the Sovereign Base Areas Administration, marked D.L.O. NEG No. 342.

**CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER MADE
UNDER SECTIONS 3 (1) AND 4 (1).**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-section (1) of sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Sugar) Order (No. 4), 1974.
2. Sugar is hereby declared to be a controlled commodity for the purpose of the Ordinance.
3. The wholesale and retail prices at which sugar may be sold in the Areas shall not exceed the maximum prices set out in the second and third columns respectively of the Schedule hereto.
4. Public Instrument No. 41 of 1974 is hereby revoked.

**CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER MADE
UNDER SECTIONS 3 (1) AND 4 (1).**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-section (1) of sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Pasteurised and/or Homogenised Cows' Milk) Order, 1974.

2. Pasteurised and/or homogenised cows' milk is hereby declared to be a controlled commodity for the purpose of this Ordinance.

3. The wholesale and retail prices at which pasteurised and/or homogenised cows' milk may be sold in the Areas, shall not exceed the maximum prices set out in the second and third columns respectively of the Schedule hereto.

4. Public Instrument No. 16 of 1973 is hereby revoked.

CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER MADE
UNDER SECTIONS 3 (1) AND 4 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-section (1) of sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Eggs) Order (No. 2), 1974.
2. Eggs are hereby declared to be a controlled commodity for the purpose of the Ordinance.
3. The maximum price at which eggs may be sold by retail in the Areas shall not exceed three hundred and twenty-five (325) mils per dozen.
4. Public Instrument No. 4 of 1974 is hereby revoked.

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS PROTECTION
ORDINANCE

(Cap. 65—Laws of Cyprus and Ordinances 19 of 1961,
17 of 1962, 19 of 1964 and 6 of 1966).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTIONS 2 AND 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2 and 3 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Ordinance, the Administrator has prescribed that the period between 1st October, 1974 and 31st January, 1975, both days inclusive, shall be a close season in addition to the close season as defined in section 2 of the Ordinance.
