THE PUBLIC ROADS (PROTECTION) ORDINANCE  
(Cap. 83—Laws of Cyprus—and Ordinance 27 of 1961).

AUTHORISATION UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 9 of the Public Roads (Protection) Ordinance and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, the Chief Officer, Sovereign Base Areas, hereby amend the Schedule to Public Instrument No. 7 of 1970, as amended by Public Instrument No. 11 of 1973, as follows :—

By adding in Part II the following under columns 1, 2 and 3 respectively :

(Ordinance No. 8 of 1973).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (g).

---

In exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (g) of Section 3 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance, 1973, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (One-Way Traffic) (Amendment) Regulations, 1975, and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles (One-Way Traffic) Regulations, 1967, as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the addition in columns 1 and 2 respectively in Part II of the Schedule of the following :

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC  
ORDINANCE

(Ordinance No. 8 of 1973).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (g).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (g) of Section 3 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance, 1973, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Restriction on Parking) (Amendment) Regulations, 1975, and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles (Restriction on Parking) Regulations, 1961, as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”).

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended as follows:—

In Part II of the Schedule insert :

(a) under the sub-head “Dhekelia Cantonment” the following additional prohibited parking zones :

- (i) “Aisne Street between its junctions with Normandy Road and Gaza Crescent”, and
- (ii) “The ambulance circuit at the British Military Hospital”;

(b) the following new sub-heads and additional prohibited parking zones :

- (i) “Dhekelia — Rhine Camp Road  
A stretch of 100 yards where the road passes the end of Kingsfield Airstrip”;
- (ii) “Ayios Nikolaos  
The southern side of Seaforth Road”.

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC  
ORDINANCE

(Ordinance No. 8 of 1973).

ORDER MADE UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by subsection (2) of Section 4 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance, 1973, I, the Chief Officer, hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Speed Limits (Amendment) Order, 1975.

2. The Schedule to Public Instrument No. 24 of 1973 is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) In Part I—(i) In column 1 of paragraph (1) “Kolossi—Akrotiri Road” delete “From the Sovereign Base Area boundary near Kolossi Castle” and substitute therefor “From the junction of the road known as the M1”;
- (ii) In column 2 of paragraph (2) “Asomatos—Akrotiri Road” delete “30” and substitute therefor “40”;
- (iii) In paragraph (3) “Royal Air Force Akrotiri” add under columns 1 and 2 respectively “Ladies Mile Road ... .. 40”;
- (iv) In column 2 of paragraph 4 in both instances delete “30” and substitute therefor “40”.
- (b) By the deletion of Part II and the substitution therefor of the following:

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS  
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

---

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Acting Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue turtle-doves, wood pigeons, rock-pigeons, bee-eaters and such vermin as sparrows, crows, magpies, jackdaws and foxes, in the area set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 20th April 1975 and ending on the 31st May, 1975.

**SCHEDULE**

The boundary of the area commences at the eastern end of Akrotiri Main State Forest boundary cairn on the sea shore south of SBA boundary pillar 266 and then runs along the edge of the said Forest in a north westerly direction up to SBA boundary pillar 257; thence it runs in a westerly direction along a track through the eucalyptus plantations north of the salt lake up to its junction with the Episkopi—Fassouri main road; thence in a south westerly direction along the Fassouri—Akrotiri main road up to the junction leading to the CYBARCO stone crushing plant; thence along the latter road up to the sea-shore; thence along the sea-shore up to the earth track leading to Curium beach, known as Ayios Ermogenis road; thence along the eastern side of the said earth track as far as its junction with Limassol—Paphos trunk road; thence south of the said trunk road in an easterly direction along the entire length of Akrotiri SBA boundary line up to boundary pillar 266 on the sea-shore; all which area is more particularly shown on a plan deposited at the Area Office Akrotiri.
