THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS (PROTECTION
AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue wild birds including such vermin as sparrows, crows, magpies, jackdaws and foxes, in the area set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 1st November 1975 and ending on the 29th February 1976, subject to the following terms and conditions :—

- (a) Shooting shall take place only between sunrise and sunset ;
- (b) No shooting shall take place within a radius of 150 yards from the outer perimeter fence of RAF Station Akrotiri or other Service installations in Akrotiri peninsula ;
- (c) No shooting shall take place within a range of 300 yards from the built-up area of any village or within 150 yards from any farm house or within any private fenced up land ;
- (d) No holder of a game licence shall enter any farm or other property where there is any likelihood of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus groves or any other plantations or to any fences ;
- (e) No fires shall be kindled ;
- (f) Between the hours of sunset and sunrise when shooting is not permitted no guns shall be carried unless they are dismantled and kept in a case ;
- (g) Shot-guns shall always be carried from and to the areas specified in this Notice dismantled ;
- (h) Holders of game licences shall always carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence as well as the certificate of registration of their gun ;
- (i) No shooting shall take place within any Game Reserve as specified by any statutory order.

SCHEDULE

All that area of land in Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area which lies east of the road known as Curium Beach Road (which

branches off the Limassol - Paphos trunk road west of Episkopi village) excluding the three Game Reserves specified in Statutory Instruments Nos. 25/1962 and 34/1968 relating to RAF Akrotiri, the Salt Lake marshes and the See of Kitium farm respectively.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 6 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974, I, the Chief Officer, hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Game Ceiling (No. 2) Order, 1975.

2. No holder of a game licence shall on any one day on which shooting is permitted be in possession of more than two hares and five partridges, or two hares, four partridges and one francolin.
