THE SUMMER TIME ORDINANCE

(Cap. 98 — Laws of Cyprus).

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR
UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Section 2 of the Summer Time Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Summer Time Order, 1976.
2. In the period specified in the Schedule hereto the time for legal and general purposes in the Areas shall be three hours in advance of Greenwich Mean Time.

SCHEDULE

From (00.00 hrs) (Greenwich Mean Time) on the 15th May, 1976 to 24.00 hrs (Greenwich Mean Time) on the 10th October, 1976.

**THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE**

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue turtle-doves, wood pigeons, rock-pigeons, bee-eaters and such vermin as sparrows, crows, magpies, jackdaws and foxes, in the area set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 18th April, 1976 and ending on the 31st May, 1976, subject to the following terms and conditions:—

- (a) shooting will only take place between sunrise and sunset ;
- (b) no dogs shall be used ;
- (c) no shooting is allowed within 200 yards of any Service installations or within 100 yards of the perimeter of the RAF Station Akrotiri ;
- (d) no fires shall be kindled ;
- (e) no shooting is allowed within 300 yards of Akrotiri village built-up area or in any private fenced up land ;
- (f) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered ;
- (g) shot-guns shall be carried from and to the area specified in this notice dismantled ;
- (h) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun.

SCHEDULE

All that area in the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area which lies south of the Limassol—Paphos trunk road up to the junction of the Curium beach road and thence south east of the road in question, with the exception of any game reserves which lie within the said area.

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue turtle-doves, wood pigeons, rock-pigeons, bee-eaters and such vermin as sparrows, crows, magpies, jackdaws and foxes, in the area set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 25th April, 1976 and ending on the 23rd May, 1976, subject to the following terms and conditions :—

- (a) shooting shall be allowed on Sundays and Wednesdays only and on the 26th and 27th April, 1976 ;
- (b) no shooting is allowed within a radius of 300 yards from any Service installations ;
- (c) shooting will only take place between sunrise and sunset ;
- (d) no dogs shall be used ;
- (e) no fires shall be kindled ;
- (f) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered ;
- (g) shot-guns shall be carried from and to the area specified in this notice dismantled ;
- (h) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun.

SCHEDULE

All that area north of the Episkopi Cantonment which is within the village boundaries of Sotira (in so far as that village lies within the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area).

THE ADOPTION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 274 — Laws of Cyprus).APPOINTMENT OF A WELFARE OFFICER UNDER
