THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 226 — Laws of Cyprus
and Ordinances 12 of 1963 and 9 of 1964).

NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

Whereas it has been represented to the Administrator that it is desirable for Service purposes to acquire certain privately-owned land in connection with a domestic water supply scheme for Episkopi Cantonment, the cost whereof is to be borne by Her Majesty's Secretary of State for Defence :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, the Administrator has been pleased to declare the said acquisition to be an undertaking of public utility and has been pleased to authorise the carrying out of the said undertaking by the Regional Estate Surveyor, Property Services Agency, Department of the Environment.

THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 226 — Laws of Cyprus
and Ordinances 12 of 1963 and 9 of 1964).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to Public Instrument No. 28 in this Supplement, notice is hereby given that the following land is required for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :—

1. All those areas of privately owned land with everything standing thereon situated in the village of Paramali, in so far as these lands fall within the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri, comprising 1 evlek 1700 square feet or thereabouts and forming part of Plot Numbers 29 and 32 in the locality "KASPARIS" of the Government Survey Plan Number LVIII. 1 for the purpose of maintaining two boreholes, which land is more particularly defined as the area coloured blue on plan No. 175 signed by the Regional Estate Surveyor, Property Services Agency, Episkopi, British Forces Post Office 53, dated 12th March 1976.

2. Part of plot 159 situated at locality "KASPARIS" of Government Survey Plan LVIII. 1, comprising an area of 1 evlek 1125 square feet or thereabouts for the purpose of constructing a Control House and Water Tanks, more particularly defined as the area coloured pink on plan No. 175 referred to above.

3. Areas of land fifteen feet wide in the aforesaid locality for the passage of vehicles and pedestrians :

- (a) along the northern boundary of Plot Nos. 56 and 55 to the area of land in Plot No. 32 referred to in paragraph 1 above ;
- (b) along the southern and western boundaries of Plot No. 32 aforesaid to the area of land in Plot 159 referred to in paragraph 1 above ;
- (c) along the boundary of Plot No. 31 from the area of land in Plot 159 aforesaid up to and along the boundary of the area of land in Plot 29 referred to in paragraph 1 ;

all of which areas are in the locality "KASPARIS" of the Government Survey Plan No. LVIII. 1 and are defined coloured brown on the plan No. 175 signed by the Regional Estate Surveyor, Property Services Agency, Episkopi, British Forces Post Office 53, dated 12th March 1976.

4. Easements and liberties for the purpose of laying, using and maintenance of a water pipeline in, over or under the following lands situated in the village of Paramali, in so far as this land falls within the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri, being part of plots Nos 97, locality "DHESPOTIKON" and 37, locality "LOURAES", of the Government Survey Plan No. LIII. 49, Part of Plots Nos. 10, 94/2, 94/3, 94/1/3, 94/1/1, 93, 92, 91, 90, 89, 88, 118 locality "ELAEOPHORIN", 119, 120, 121, 123, 131, 132/1, 132/2, locality "KOKKINOS", 134, 177, locality "AMMOS", 165, 166, 161, 160 locality "KASPARIS", of the Government Survey Plan No. LIII. 57, and part of plots Nos. 30, 31 and 32 locality "KASPARIS" of the Government Survey Plan No. LVIII. 1.

The route of the said water pipeline is more particularly defined as the line coloured red on the Plan No. 175 signed by the Regional Estate Surveyor, Property Services Agency, Episkopi, British Forces Post Office 53, dated 12th March, 1976.

5. Easements to carry overhead electric wires from the area of land in plot No. 159 referred to in paragraph 1 above to the areas of land in plots 29 and 32 referred to in the same paragraph which easements are over Plot Nos. 31 and 32 of the Government Survey Plan No. LVIII. 1 in the "KASPARIS" locality, the routes of which easements are shown by green line on the plan No. 175 signed by the Regional Estate Surveyor, Property Services Agency, Episkopi, British Forces Post Office 53, dated 12th March, 1976.

Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said land who objects to the acquisition is required, within fourteen days from the date of the publication of this notice, to send me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

Her Majesty's Secretary of State for Defence is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said land.

A plan showing the land described above is available for inspection at the Area Office, Sovereign Base Area, Akrotiri.

THE SEA BATHERS (PROTECTION) ORDINANCE, 1968

(Ordinance No. 16 of 1968).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Sea Bathers (Protection) Ordinance, 1968, I, the Chief Officer, hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Bathers (Protection) Order, 1976.

2. The areas specified in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "reserved areas") are reserved exclusively for persons bathing in the sea, subject to the conditions and restrictions set out in the said Schedule in respect of each area :

Provided that the restrictions relating to the sailing of boats within the reserved areas shall only have effect between sunrise and sunset.

3. The reserved areas shall be demarcated by buoys.

4. This Order shall become operative on the 1st day of May, 1976, and cease to have effect on the 31st day of October, 1976.

SCHEDULE

SOVEREIGN BASE AREA AKROTIRI

1. Tunnel Beach Episkopi.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 85603587 of Sheet 23, series K717, edition 2-GSGS, to a point under map reference 85503585 ; then westwards at a distance of about 100 yards from the shore for about 600 yards to a point under map reference 84943606, whence the distance from the shore increases to about 200 yards as far as a point under map reference 84443609 and then proceeds in a north westerly direction to a point under map reference 84413618 and from thence to the shore at a point under map reference 84323630.

2. Happy Valley Beach Episkopi.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 83523573 of Sheet 23, series K717, edition 2-GSGS to a point under map reference 83303562 ; thence westwards at a distance of about 220 yards from the shore for about 800 yards to a point under map reference 82593573 and it then proceeds westwards to the headland under map reference 82433567.

3. Paramali Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 824356 of Sheet 23, series K717, edition 2-GSGS to a point under map reference 324355, a distance of 220 yards from the shore, and continuing at that distance westwards to a point under map reference 807358.

4. Evdhimou Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 789359 of Sheet 23, series K717, edition 2-GSGS to a point under map reference 780357 on the west within a distance of about 150 yards from the shore.

5. Royal Air Force Station Akrotiri.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by lines opposite the eastern shore of the Akrotiri peninsula at a distance from the shore varying from 300 feet to 800 feet as marked with orange plastic buoys and running in a north-westerly direction —

(a) from a point under map reference 026267 to a point under map reference 015278

and

(b) from a point under map reference 033254 to a point under map reference 031256

of Sheet 23, series K717, Edition 2-GSGS :

Provided that sailing vessels and speed boats may enter the area designated at paragraph (a) above through a sea lane of an approximate width of 20 yards which shall be marked with orange plastic buoys.

6. Ladies Mile Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas stretching out to 500 feet from high water mark from boundary pillar No. 266 on the Sovereign Base Area boundary and extending southwards up to a point opposite the shore under map reference 009285 of Sheet 23, series K197, Edition 2-GSGS :

Provided that motor launches and sailing vessels may enter the said area through two sea lanes, one of an approximate width of 50 yards and the other of an approximate width of 400 yards both of which shall be marked with orange plastic buoys.

Copies of the maps referred to above are properly marked and deposited at the Area Office of the Sovereign Base Areas Administration Akrotiri for inspection by any interested person.

SOVEREIGN BASE AREA DHEKELIA

1. Officers' Club Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 67897116 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 4-T-GSGS, to a point westwards under map reference 67457110 ; thence northwards to a point on the headland under map reference 67457119.

2. CESSAC (Church of England Soldiers', Sailors', Airmen's Club) Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 67147133 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 4-T-GSGS, to a point westwards on the coast under map reference 66737129.

3. St. George's Club Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 66367119 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 4-T-GSGS to a point westwards on the headland under map reference 66097118.

4. Victory Club (Off Alexander Barracks).

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the shore under map reference 65407126 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 4-T-GSGS to a point southwards under map reference 65407115; thence westwards in a straight line to a point under map reference 65297115; thence northwards to the shore to a point under map reference 65297125.

5. Charlie's Casino Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the shore under map reference 643711 of Sheet 21, series K717, edition 1-GSGS to a point southwards under map reference 643710; thence westwards in a straight line to a point under map reference 641710; thence northwards to the shore to a point under map reference 641711; all which area stretches for 300 yards along the coast and at a distance of 100 yards from high water mark.

Copies of the maps referred to above are properly marked and deposited at the Area Office of the Sovereign Base Areas Administration Dhekelia for inspection by any interested person.
