THE PUBLIC WATERWORKS ORDINANCE

(Cap. 341—Laws of Cyprus—and Ordinance 4 of 1969).

THE POLEMIDHIA (GARYLLIS) AND YERMASOYIA PUBLIC  
WATERWORKS (REGULATION AND MANAGEMENT)  
REGULATIONS, 1976.

---

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him under Regulation 4 of the Polemidhia (Garyllis) and Yermasoyia Public Waterworks (Regulation and Management) Regulations 1976, the Administrator has fixed the following rates to be paid each proprietor :—

- (a) for the irrigation of citrus, bananas, vineyards or deciduous trees (other than fig trees), 15 mils for each cubic meter of water supplied or used ;
- (b) for the irrigation of vegetable crops, wheat, barley or oats or other crops not falling within paragraph (a) above, 10 mils for each cubic meter of water supplied or used ;
- (c) for the irrigation of any crops from the overflow of the dams, 3 mils for each cubic meter of water supplied or used ;
- (d) in all cases falling within the proviso to Regulation 4, £2 annually for each donum of land for which water has not been used as stipulated in the said proviso, unless the Committee has decided that the quantity of water in question has not been used for reasons strictly beyond the control of the proprietor.

**THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS  
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE**

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

**NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue turtle-doves, wood pigeons, rock-pigeons, quail and other wild birds, including such vermin as sparrows, crows, magpies, jackdaws and foxes, in the area set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 22nd August 1976 and ending on the 28th February 1977, subject to the following terms and conditions:—

- (a) shooting will only take place between sunrise and sunset ;
- (b) no dogs shall be used in that part of the area set out in the Schedule hereto which lies south of the M1 and west of the Fassouri farm ;
- (c) no shooting is allowed within 200 yards of any Service installations or within 100 yards of the perimeter of the RAF Station Akrotiri ;
- (d) no fires shall be kindled ;
- (e) no shooting is allowed within 300 yards of Akrotiri village built-up area or in any private fenced up land ;
- (f) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered ;
- (g) shot-guns shall be carried from and to the area specified in this notice dismantled ;
- (h) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun.

2. This notice may be revoked at any time.

**SCHEDULE**

All that area in the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area which lies south of the Limassol — Paphos trunk road up to the junction of the Curium beach road and thence south east of the road in question, with the exception of any game reserves which lie within the said area.
