THE CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (ANIMALS) ORDINANCE

(Cap. 45 — Laws of Cyprus — and Ordinances 3 of 1969 and 6 of 1969).

ORDER UNDER SECTIONS 3, 4(1)(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g) and 7,

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 3, 4(1)(a). (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g) and 7 of the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby orders as follows:—

- This Order may be cited as the Brucellosis (Amendment) Order, 1977 and shall be read as one with the Brucellosis Order. 1975 as amended by the Brucellosis (Amendment) Order, 1975 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").
- The principal Order is hereby amended by deleting paragraph 5A thereof and substituting therefor the following new paragraph:---

"5A. If, during the examination of any animal in the Areas, as provided in paragraph 4 of the principal Order, it is established that it is infected with Brucellosis such animal shall be seized and removed forthwith from the infected farm or infected flock to a place under the control of the Chief Officer or any other person authorised by him to that effect."

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS (PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue turtle-doves, wood pigeons, rock-pigeons, bee-eaters and other wild birds including such vermin as sparrows, crows, magpies, jackdaws and foxes, in the area set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 17th April, 1977 and ending on the 22nd May 1977, subject to the following terms and conditions:—

- (a) shooting shall take place between sunrise and sunset only;
- (b) no dogs shall be used;
- (c) there shall be no shooting within 200 yards of any service installations or within 100 yards of the perimeter of the RAF Station Akrotiri;
- (d) no fires shall be kindled;
- (e) there shall be no shooting within 300 yards of Akrotiri village built up area or in any private fenced up land;
- (f) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered;
- (g) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun.

SCHEDULE

All that area in the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area which lies south of the Limassol-Paphos trunk road up to the junction of the Curium beach road and thence south east of the road in question, with the exception of any game reserves which lie within the said area.

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS (PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue turtle-doves, wood pigeons, rock-pigeons, bee-eaters and other wild birds including such vermin as sparrows, crows, magpies, jackdaws and foxes, in the areas set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 17th April, 1977 and ending on the 22nd May 1977, subject to the following terms and conditions:—

- (a) shooting shall take place between sunrise and sunset on Sundays and Wednesdays only;
- (b) no dogs shall be used;
- (c) no fires shall be kindled;
- (d) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered;
- (e) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun.

SCHEDULE

All the areas north of the Episkopi Cantonment and Paramali married quarters which are within the village boundaries of Sotira and Paramali respectively (in so far as those villages lie within the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area) other than the Game Reserve described in Public Instrument No. 92 of 1976.
