THE CONTROL (ENTRY, SETTLEMENT AND COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISES) ORDINANCE 1960

(Ordinances 5 of 1960 and 5 of 1971).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 23.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 23 of the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) Ordinance, 1960 the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) (Business Licences) (Amendment) Regulations, 1977 and shall be read as one with the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) (Business Licences) Regulations, 1960 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the abbreviation and figure "£5" appearing in the first line thereof and substituting therefor the abbreviation and figure "£1".

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1978, without prejudice to anything done or left undone under the principal Regulations.

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS (PROTECTION AND
DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinance No. 11 of 1974).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTIONS 2 AND 26.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Sections 2 and 26 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Ordinance, the Administrator has prescribed that the periods specified in the Schedule hereto shall be a close season in addition to the close season as defined in Section 2 of the Ordinance.

- (a) The period between 1st October 1977 and 5th November 1977, both days inclusive.
