**NOTICE UNDER SECTION 14 (1).**

---

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 14 (1) of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Ordinance, the Area Officer, Dhekelia, as the appropriate authority for the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia, does hereby, with the approval of the Administrator, define the areas described in the Schedule hereto as zones wherein structures for the mass breeding of animals and poultry shall or shall not be allowed; all which areas are more particularly defined on Drawing No. D1, dated 5th December, 1977 and deposited at the Area Office, Dhekelia.

**S C H E D U L E**

**ZONE A.**

All that area within the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia, coloured blue on Drawing No. D1, of 5th December, 1977, wherein no structures for the mass breeding of animals and poultry of any kind shall be allowed.

**ZONE B.**

All that area within the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia, coloured red on Drawing No. D1, of 5th December, 1977, wherein there shall be no restrictions to structures to be used for the mass breeding of animals and poultry.

**ZONE C.**

All that area within the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia, coloured green on Drawing No. D1, of 5th December, 1977, wherein no structures for the mass breeding of pigs shall be allowed.

THE CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (ANIMALS) ORDINANCE

(Cap. 45 — Laws of Cyprus — and  
Ordinances 3 and 6 of 1969).

GENERAL ORDERS AND REGULATIONS MADE BY  
THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsections (1) and (2) of Section 4 of the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following General Orders and Regulations :—

1. These General Orders and Regulations may be cited as the Contagious Diseases (Animals) (Amendment) General Orders and Regulations, 1977 and shall be read as one with the Contagious Diseases (Animals) General Orders and Regulations, as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as the “principal General Orders and Regulations”).

2. The principal General Orders and Regulations (as amended by the Contagious Diseases (Animals) (Amendment) General Orders and Regulations, 1969 are hereby amended by deleting paragraphs 26E, 26F and 26G inclusive and substituting therefor the following new paragraphs :—

P. I. No. 19/69.

“26E.—(1) Every carcase or organ of an animal affected, or suspected of being affected, with hydatosis shall be disposed of by the local authority or the mukhtar of the village, as the case may be, in which such carcase or organ lies, by burning it at the premises at which it lies or at any place indicated for the purpose by the Area Officer.

(2) Where the provisions of sub-paragraph (1) of this paragraph cannot be applied, every owner or any person in whose care or control any animal is found, which has died of, or is suspected of being affected with, hydatosis shall forthwith destroy it by burning it or by burying it at a depth of six feet, after soaking it with a strong antiseptic.

26F.—The feeding of dogs with raw organs of any animal affected, or suspected of being affected, with hydatosis is prohibited.

26G.—(1) No dog shall be permitted, and no person shall permit any dog belonging to him, to enter any premises or place where animals are slaughtered or where carcasses or organs of animals exist or are destroyed or otherwise disposed of.

(2) Every dog owner or person in whose care or control any dog is found shall ensure that such dog is under his immediate supervision and is not exposed to any risks of hydatosis infection as a result of his actions or omissions.

(3) No person shall, without a written permit from the Chief Officer, remove any shepherd's dog from any area where the requisite examination against hydatosis has been carried out."

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS  
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

---

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue wood pigeons, rock-pigeons, quail and other wild birds, including such vermin as sparrows, crows, jackdaws and foxes, in the area set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 1st January, 1978 and ending on the 26th February, 1978 subject to the following terms and conditions :—

- (a) shooting shall take place on Sundays and Wednesdays only ;
- (b) no dogs shall be used ;
- (c) no fires shall be kindled ;
- (d) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered ;
- (e) shot-guns shall be carried from and to the area specified in this notice dismantled ;
- (f) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun.

2. This notice may be revoked at any time.

**SCHEDULE**

The area commences at boundary pillar 37 north of the Limassol—Paphos road and west of Paramali Station ; thence it runs along the SBA boundary in a north easterly direction ; thence along the said boundary up to boundary pillar 108 ; thence in a south easterly direction along the "Krommya" watercourse up to a point where the said watercourse meets the Limassol—Paphos road and thence along that road in a westerly direction up to the point of commencement, excluding the Game Reserve described in P. I. No. 92 of 1976.

## THE WELLS ORDINANCE

(Cap. 351 — Laws of Cyprus — and Ordinance 6 of 1971).

## NOTICE UNDER SECTION 4 (2).

Whereas the Administrator, being satisfied that special measures for the conservation of water in the area set out in the Schedule hereto are necessary in the public interest, proposes to make an Order in respect of such area under section 4 of the Wells Ordinance :

Now, therefore, by the direction of the Administrator notice is hereby given that the particulars of the proposed Order shall be as set out in the Schedule hereto and that a copy of the draft of the proposed Order and every relevant map and plan may be inspected at the office of the Area Officer, Akrotiri in which the area affected is situated during office hours and free of charge, during a period of fourteen days of the publication of this notice in the Gazette and that any person may, within the same period, by notice addressed to the Area Officer, Akrotiri, object to the making of the Order.

## SCHEDULE

The boundary commences at the point on the sea-shore where the boundary of the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area commences near Boundary Pillar No. 1 and proceeds in a northerly, north-easterly and south-easterly direction along the said boundary of the said Area to a point where the said boundary is cut by the Limassol-Paphos main road, between Boundary Pillars No. 118 and 119; thence in a westerly direction along the said main road to the most western point of plot No. 127 of Survey Plan No. LVIII.5, which point is on a road leading to the sea-shore known as the Curium beach road; thence in a south-westerly direction along the said road to the north-western corner of plot No. 24 of Survey Plan No. LVIII.12, which corner is on the sea-shore; thence in a westerly direction along the said sea-shore to the point of commencement, all which said area is more particularly defined on the map marked Serial No. 2735.
