ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

---

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 3 of the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurers) (Consolidation) Order, 1978.

## THE FIRE SERVICES ORDINANCE, 1968

(Ordinance No. 1 of 1968).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 8 of the Fire Services Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fire Services (Establishment of Senior Fire Officers) Regulations, 1978.

2. In these Regulations :—

“member of the Sovereign Base Areas Police Force” means a “member of the force” as defined in the Police Ordinance, 1967 ;

“military fire service” means a Fire Service attached to Her Majesty’s Naval, Military or Air Forces in the Island of Cyprus ;

“Officer” means any member of a fire service, military or civil.

3.—(1) Where more than one Fire Service is present at a fire in the Areas which is damaging or threatening damage to aircraft, the Senior officer of the Fire Service attached to the Royal Air Force shall, if such fire service is present, be the Senior Fire Officer.

(2) Where more than one Fire Service including a military fire service is present at a fire in the Areas (other than a fire to which paragraph (1) of this regulation applies) the officer senior in rank in the military fire service present (or if more than one military fire service is present the officer senior in rank or equivalent rank among all the military fire services present) shall be the Senior Fire Officer.

(3) Where more than one Fire Service (not including a military fire service) is present at a fire in the Areas the senior member of the Sovereign Base Areas Police Force present shall be the Senior Fire Officer.

4. The Fire Services (Establishment of Senior Fire Officers) Regulations, 1977 are hereby revoked.
