THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ORDINANCE, 1969

(Ordinances 12 of 1969, 9 of 1971,
2 of 1975, 4 and 8 of 1977).

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR
UNDER SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION 128.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-section (1) of Section 128 of the Customs and Excise Ordinance, 1969, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Native Tobacco (Cultivation) Regulations, 1978.

2. In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires—

“dealer” means a person holding a Native Tobacco Dealer’s licence issued either under the provisions of the Ordinance or of the Republican Law ;

“grower” means a person licensed to plant, cultivate and grow tobacco ;

“officer” or “officer of customs and excise” means any officer of Customs and Excise appointed by the Fiscal Officer for the purposes of these Regulations ;

“Republican Law” means the Customs and Excise Law 1967 of the Republic and any Republican Law amending or substituted for the same.

CULTIVATION

3. No person shall plant, cultivate or grow any tobacco unless he has completed and submitted to the Fiscal Officer an application and undertaking in the form set out in the Schedule to these Regulations and has obtained a licence.

4. Save as permitted by the Fiscal Officer, a licence shall not be granted in pursuance of any application made under Regulation 3 unless it is in respect of an area of not less than two donums.

5. A licence issued in pursuance of an application made under Regulation 3 shall be granted subject to compliance with the undertaking given by the applicant in his application.

6. A grower shall notify the officer when tobacco grown by him is ready for weighing and shall render to the officer all necessary assistance in weighing it.

7. A grower shall not allow any tobacco to be removed from his premises unless it is accompanied by a permit, certificate, waybill or other document in such form as the Fiscal Officer may direct, issued by an officer.

8. A grower shall obtain a receipt in such form as the Fiscal Officer may direct, for all tobacco delivered from his premises. Every such receipt shall be kept by the grower for a period of not less than six months from the date of delivery of the tobacco from his premises and shall be produced to any officer on request.

APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE TO CULTIVATE TOBACCO.

NOTE :— A separate application is required for each village area at which tobacco is to be grown.

I, (full name) being the occupier of donums of land at in the village of hereby make application for a licence to cultivate thereon yellow leaf/Virginia * tobacco during the year ending 31st October, 19.....

In consideration of a licence being granted to me in pursuance of this application.

I UNDERTAKE :—

- (a) to notify the Fiscal Officer if the area actually planted by me is other than that specified above ;
- (b) to notify the Fiscal Officer of any accidental loss or destruction of any tobacco grown by me ;
- (c) not to destroy, permit or cause to be destroyed, except with the permission of an Officer of Customs and Excise and not to use, permit or cause to be used, by smoking or otherwise, any tobacco cultivated under the authority of such licence.

I further UNDERTAKE that I shall not remove, permit or cause to be removed, from my premises at ** any tobacco so cultivated until it has been produced to, and weighed by an Officer of Customs and Excise and that I will hold myself liable for the excise duty chargeable thereon at all times until either it has been received by a licensed dealer in tobacco or has been otherwise accounted for in accordance with the Ordinance and that I will truthfully answer all questions put to me by any Officer of Customs and Excise concerning the type, cultivation, drying and disposal or other matter relating to such tobacco.

THE SEA BATHERS (PROTECTION) ORDINANCE, 1968

(Ordinance No. 16 of 1968).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Sea Bathers (Protection) Ordinance, 1968, I, the Chief Officer, hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Bathers (Protection) Order, 1978.

2. The areas specified in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as “reserved areas”) are reserved exclusively for persons bathing in the sea, subject to the conditions and restrictions set out in the said Schedule in respect of each area :

Provided that the restrictions relating to the sailing of boats within the reserved areas shall only have effect between sunrise and sunset.

3. The reserved areas shall be demarcated by buoys.

4. This Order shall become operative on the 16th day of May, 1978, and cease to have effect on the 31st day of October, 1978.

SCHEDULE**SOVEREIGN BASE AREA AKROTIRI****1. Tunnel Beach Episkopi.**

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 85603587 of Sheet 23, series K717, edition 2-GSGS, to a point under map reference 85503585 ; then westwards at a distance of about 100 yards from the shore for about 600 yards to a point under map reference 84943606, whence the distance from the shore increases to about 200 yards as far as a point under map reference 84443609 and then proceeds in a north westerly direction to a point under map reference 84413618 and from thence to the shore at a point under map reference 84323630.

2. Happy Valley Beach Episkopi.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 83523573 of Sheet 23, series K717, edition 2-GSGS to a point under map reference 83303562 ; thence westwards at a distance of about 220 yards from the shore for about 800 yards to a point under map reference 82593573 and it then proceeds westwards to the headland under map reference 82433567.

3. Paramali Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 824356 of Sheet 23, series K717, edition 2-GSGS to a point under map reference 824355, a distance of 220 yards from the shore, and continuing at that distance westwards to a point under map reference 807358.

4. Evdhimou Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas 30 metres to the west of the Jetty under map reference 787353 of Sheet 23 Series K717 edition 2-GSGS to a point under map reference 781353 within a distance of 60 metres from the shore as marked by buoys. The area from point 789352 to a point due south 60 metres from the shore and thence eastwards within a distance of 60 metres from the shore as marked by buoys to a point on the shore at map reference 792352.

5. Royal Air Force Station Akrotiri.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by lines opposite the eastern shore of the Akrotiri peninsula at a distance from the shore varying from 300 feet to 800 feet as marked with buoys and running in a north - westerly direction —

(a) from a point under map reference 026267 to a point under map reference 015278

and

(b) from a point under map reference 033254 to a point under map reference 031256

of Sheet 23, series K717, Edition 2-GSGS :

Provided that sailing vessels and speed boats may enter the area designated at paragraph (a) above through a sea lane of an approximate width of 20 yards which shall be marked with buoys.

6. Ladies Mile Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas stretching out to 500 feet from high water mark from boundary pillar No. 266 on the Sovereign Base Area boundary and extending southwards up to a point opposite the shore under map reference 010283 of Sheet 23, series K197, Edition 2-GSGS :

Provided that motor launches and sailing vessels may enter the said area through two sea lanes, one of an approximate width of 50 yards and the other of an approximate width of 400 yards both of which shall be marked with buoys :

Provided further that the foreshore under this paragraph shall include land within a distance from high water mark not exceeding 10 yards.

Copies of the maps referred to above are properly marked and deposited at the Area Office of the Sovereign Base Areas Administration Akrotiri for inspection by any interested person.

SOVEREIGN BASE AREA DHEKELIA

1. Officers' Club Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 67897116 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 4-T-GSGS, to a point westwards under map reference 67457110 ; thence northwards to a point on the headland under map reference 67457119.

2. CESSAC (Church of England Soldiers', Sailors', Airmen's Club) Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 67187143 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 4-T-GSGS, then southwards to a point under map reference 67107132 and then to a point westwards on the coast under map reference 66737129.

3. St. George's Club Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 66367119 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 4-T-GSGS to a point westwards on the headland under map reference 66097118.

4. Victory Club (Off Alexander Barracks).

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the shore under map reference 65407126 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 4-T-GSGS to a point southwards under map reference 65407115; thence westwards in a straight line to a point under map reference 65297115; thence northwards to the shore to a point under map reference 65297125.

5. Charlie's Casino Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the shore under map reference 643711 of Sheet 21, series K717, edition 1-GSGS to a point southwards under map reference 643710; thence westwards in a straight line to a point under map reference 641710; thence northwards to the shore to a point under map reference 641711; all of which area stretches for 300 yards along the coast and at a distance of 100 yards from high water mark.

Copies of the maps referred to above are properly marked and deposited at the Area Office of the Sovereign Base Areas Administration Dhekelia for inspection by any interested person.
