THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

GAME RESERVE ORDER.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-section (1) of Section 29 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974 the Administrator hereby declares the five areas specified in the Schedule hereto to be Game Reserves :—

S C H E D U L E

Area 'A'

That part of the property belonging to the Limassol Bishopric at Akrotiri peninsula, known as Ayios Nicolaos farm, which is enclosed by a barbed wire fence.

Area 'B'

The boundary of the area commences at BP 242; thence it runs in a northerly and north-easterly direction along the SBA boundary to BP 220; thence westerly along the unsurfaced road from Trakhoni to its junction with the main Kolossi-Akrotiri road (9430 3580); thence southwards to the M. 1 junction; thence westerly along the M. 1 to the M. 1 bridge; thence south-easterly along an earth track running through Ayios Dhimitrianos church up to its junction with the Upper Marsh track; thence along that track up to its junction with the loop on Kolossi-Akrotiri road (9480 3185) thence eastwards along the boundary of the Akrotiri Main State Forest to BP 242.

Area 'C'

The boundary of the area commences at BP 201; thence it runs northward to BP 194; thence south westerly along a track (9830 3620); thence westerly along a track from Zakaki to Kolossi to its junction (9735 3570) with an earth track running southwards; thence along that track up to the SBA boundary (9770 3485); thence eastwards along the boundary to BP 201.

Area 'D'

The boundary of the area commences at the junction between the M. 1 and the Kolossi-Akrotiri road; thence it runs northwards and westwards along the SBA boundary south of Kolossi village up to the eastern bank of Kouris river; thence southwards along the eastern bank of Kouris river up to the M. 1; thence in an easterly direction along the M. 1 up to the point of commencement.

Area 'E'

The boundary commences on the western side of the M. 1 bridge and runs along an earth track towards Episkopi village; thence westwards along the SBA boundary south of Episkopi village up to the Limassol-Paphos road; thence along the said road up to the M. 1 junction; thence along the M. 1 road up to the point of commencement.

Area 'F'

The boundary commences at the junction of a track leading into the Limassol-Paphos road at a distance of about 300 yards east of the SBA Police Station at Episkopi; thence it runs along the said track in a north easterly direction up to a point where it meets the earth track leading to Sotira village; thence along that track in a south easterly direction up to an electricity sub-station; thence eastwards within a radius of 400 yards from Curium Stadium and other antiquity sites in the vicinity up to the Limassol-Paphos road; thence westwards along the said road up to the point of commencement.

The map references are to the Cyprus: 1:50,000 Series K717, Edition 2-GSGS, Sheet 23.

**THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE**

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue turtle-doves, wood pigeons, rock-pigeons, bee-eaters and other wild birds including such vermin as sparrows, crows, magpies, jackdaws and foxes, in the areas set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 22nd April, 1979 and ending on the 13th May, 1979, subject to the following terms and conditions:—

- (a) shooting shall take place between sunrise and sunset on Sundays and Wednesdays only and on Monday the 23rd April, 1979;
- (b) no dogs shall be used ;
- (c) no fires shall be kindled ;
- (d) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered ;
- (e) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun.

S C H E D U L E

All the areas north of the Episkopi Cantonment and Paramali married quarters which are within the village boundaries of Sotira and Paramali respectively (in so far as those villages lie within the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area) other than any game reserves which lie within the said area.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue turtle-doves, wood pigeons, rock-pigeons, bee-eaters and other wild birds including such vermin as sparrows, crows, magpies, jackdaws and foxes, in the areas set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 22nd April, 1979 and ending on the 13th May, 1979, subject to the following terms and conditions :—

- (a) shooting shall take place between sunrise and sunset on Sundays and Wednesdays only and on Monday the 23rd April, 1979;
- (b) no dogs shall be used ;
- (c) there shall be no shooting within 200 yards of any service installations or within 100 yards of the perimeter of the RAF Station Akrotiri ;
- (d) no fires shall be kindled ;
- (e) there shall be no shooting within 300 yards of Akrotiri village built-up area or in any private fenced up land ;
- (f) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered ;
- (g) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun.

S C H E D U L E

All that area in the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area which lies south of the Limassol-Paphos trunk road up to the junction of the Curium beach road and thence south east of the road in question, other than any game reserves which lie within the said area.
