THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

GAME RESERVE ORDER.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Section 29 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974 the Administrator hereby declares the whole of the Akrotiri Salt Lake, as demarcated on the ground, to be a Game Reserve.

2. P. I. No. 49 of 1977 is hereby revoked.

THE PUBLIC ROADS (PROTECTION) ORDINANCE

(Cap. 83 and 2 of 1960 — Laws of Cyprus —
Ordinance 27 of 1961).

AUTHORISATION UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 9 of the Public Roads (Protection) Ordinance and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, the Chief Officer, Sovereign Base Areas, hereby amend the Schedule to Public Instrument No. 77 of 1978 by deleting Part II thereto and substituting therefor the following new Part II:—

**CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER
MADE UNDER SECTIONS 3 (1) AND 4 (1).**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Fresh Beef, Lamb, Goat and Pork) (Amendment) Order, 1979 and shall be read as one with the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Fresh Beef, Lamb, Goat and Pork) Order, 1978 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Order”).

THE PRISONS ORDINANCE, 1971

(Ordinance 11 of 1971)

THE POLICE ORDINANCE, 1967

(Ordinances 9 of 1967 and 14 of 1969).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION (2)
OF SECTION 15 OF THE PRISONS ORDINANCE, 1971,
READ WITH SECTION 9 OF THE POLICE ORDINANCE, 1967,
AND SECTION 12 OF THE PRISONS ORDINANCE.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by subsection (2) of Section 15 of the Prisons Ordinance, 1971, read with Section 9 of the Police Ordinance, 1967, and Section 12 of the Prisons Ordinance, I, the Chief Police Officer and Superintendent of Prisons, with the approval of the Administrator, hereby make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police and Prison Officers (General) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 1979, and shall, where they apply to the Police (General) Regulations, 1967, as amended from time to time, hereinafter referred to as “the principal Police Regulations”, be read as one with those Regulations, and where they apply to the Police (General) Regulations, 1967, as modified by paragraph 2 and Appendix II of Public Instrument No. 60 of 1971 and thereby made applicable to, and made to relate to, the service of prison officers, be read as one with such Regulations as so modified, which are hereinafter referred to as “the principal Prison Officers Regulations”.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Police and the principal Prison Officers Regulations is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph :—

“The above scales are increased as follows :

- (a) from 1st May to 30th September, 1979, both dates inclusive, six per centum (6%) subject to a minimum increase of £47 per annum ;
- (b) from 1st October, 1979 to 31st January, 1980, both dates inclusive, three per centum (3%) shall be added to basic salaries as they have been increased by virtue of paragraph (a) above subject to a minimum increase of £25 per annum ;

- (c) from 1st February, 1980 a total increase of seven per centum (7%) shall be added to basic salaries as they have been increased by virtue of paragraph (a) above, namely it includes the increase of three per centum (3%) stipulated in paragraph (b) above, subject to a minimum increase of £58 per annum, namely it includes the minimum increase of £25 per annum stipulated in paragraph (b) above.”.

THE AKROTIRI VILLAGE
(SPECIAL PROVISIONS) ORDINANCE, 1966

(Ordinances 3 of 1966 and 9 of 1979).

REVOCATION AND NOTICE MADE BY THE
ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SUBSECTION (8) OF SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by subsection (8) of Section 4 of the Akrotiri Village (Special Provisions) Ordinance, 1966 the Administrator hereby revokes Public Instrument No. 70 of 1979 without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.
