THE INDUSTRIAL TRAINING AUTHORITY
(REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS) (RECOGNITION)
ORDINANCE, 1979

(Ordinance 1 of 1979).

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR
UNDER SECTIONS 9 AND 15.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Sections 9 and 15 of the Industrial Training Authority (Republic of Cyprus) (Recognition) Ordinance, 1979 the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Industrial Training Authority (Employers' Levy) (Amendment) Regulations, 1979 and shall be read as one with the Industrial Training Authority (Employers' Levy) Regulations, 1979 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. The first proviso to Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended :—

- (a) by deleting the word "thirty" appearing in the second line thereof and substituting therefor the word "sixty"; and
- (b) by deleting the words "one hundred and thirty" appearing in the second and third lines thereof and substituting therefor the words "two hundred and sixty".

3. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into effect on 5th November, 1979.

(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 6 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974, I, the Chief Officer, hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Game (Ceiling) Order, 1979.
 2. The number of game that may be shot or possessed by the holder of a game licence on any one day shall not exceed five partridges, or four partridges and one francolin.
