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THE FORESHORE PROTECTION ORDINANCE

(Ordinance 9 of 1975).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Section 3 (1) of the Foreshore Protection Ordinance, I do hereby prohibit —

- (a) the digging, extracting, loading or heaping of stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance within the part of the foreshore specified in the Schedule hereto or removing the same therefrom or the attempting of doing any of the aforesaid acts ;
- (b) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night soil or other refuse, oil, engine oil, or any other fluid lubrication oil, solid or liquid sludge oil —
 - (i) on any part of the foreshore specified in the Schedule hereto ;
 - (ii) on any point in the sea opposite the foreshore specified in the Schedule hereto, within a distance of less than two hundred yards from low water mark ;
 - (iii) from any pier, wharf, quay or jetty along the foreshore specified in the Schedule hereto ;
 - (iv) from any tanker, ship or vessel which may be in, or passing through, the territorial waters of the Areas opposite the foreshore specified in the Schedule hereto ;
- (c) the erecting, placing or leaving within the foreshore specified in the Schedule hereto of any vessel, caravan, cart, wheel-barrow, kiosk, tent, receptacle, commercial goods, commercial materials or equipment or anything similar to the aforesaid vessels, goods, articles, materials, equipment or construction.

2. For the purpose of this Notice "foreshore" includes any land within a distance of one hundred yards from high water mark as specified in P. I. No. 66 of 1965.

3. Public Instrument No. 6 of 1971 is hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done thereunder.

The whole of the foreshore of the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri.

THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS
REGULATION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 96 and Law No. 14 of 1959 — Laws of Cyprus —
and Ordinances 23 of 1961, 29 of 1963, 16 of 1964,
5 of 1974 and 10 of 1978).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 14 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 14 (1) of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Ordinance, the Area Officer Dhekelia, as the appropriate authority for the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia, does hereby, with the approval of the Administrator, define the areas described in the Schedule hereto as zones wherein structures for the mass breeding of animals and poultry shall or shall not be allowed; all which areas are more particularly defined on Drawing No. D 3 dated 15th February, 1980 and deposited at the Area Office, Dhekelia.

SCHEDULE

ZONE A

All that area within the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia, coloured blue on Drawing No. D 3 of 15th February, 1980, wherein no structures for the mass breeding of animals and poultry of any kind shall be allowed.

ZONE B

All that area within the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia, coloured green on Drawing No. D 3 of 15th February, 1980, wherein no structures for the mass breeding of pigs shall be allowed but wherein there shall be no restrictions to structures to be used for the mass breeding of other animals, and poultry.
