(DECLARATION OF DEATH AND LEGITIMATION)
(AMENDMENT) RULES, 1980.

RULES OF COURT MADE UNDER SECTION 52 OF THE WILLS
AND SUCCESSION ORDINANCE AND SECTION 15 OF THE
ILLEGITIMATE CHILDREN ORDINANCE.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 52 of the Wills and Succession Ordinance and Section 15 of the Illegitimate Children Ordinance, the Administrator, with the advice and assistance of the Senior Judge, hereby makes the following Rules :—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Wills and Succession (Declaration of Death and Legitimation of Children) (Amendment) Rules, 1980, and shall be read as one with the Wills and Succession (Declaration of Death and Legitimation) Rules as amended by the Wills and Succession (Declaration of Death and Legitimation of Children) (Amendment) Rules, 1979 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”).

2. The principal Rules are hereby amended by inserting immediately after Rule 21, of the following new Rules to be numbered 21A and 21B, respectively :

“21A. The costs of any proceedings shall be at the discretion of the Court.

21B. Subject to any special order of the Court, the fees to be allowed to advocates as between themselves and their clients, or as between the parties, in respect of any proceedings under these Rules shall be those laid down in Appendix B of the Civil Procedure (Amendment) Rules, 1979, for claims between two hundred and five hundred pounds.”

RULES OF COURT MADE UNDER SECTION 10.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 10 of the Compensation Assessment Tribunal Ordinance, the Administrator, with the advice and assistance of the Senior Judge, hereby makes the following Rules :—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Compensation Assessment Tribunal (Amendment) Rules, 1980, and shall be read as one with the Compensation Assessment Tribunal Rules, 1956 as amended by the Compensation Assessment Tribunal (Amendment) Rules, 1979 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules").

RULES OF COURT MADE UNDER SECTION 9
AND SUBSECTION (4) OF SECTION 25.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Adoption (Amendment) Rules, 1980, and shall be read as one with the Adoption Rules, 1954 as amended by the Adoption (Amendment) Rules, 1979 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules").
