INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 1 — Laws of Cyprus).DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY UNDER SECTION 22.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 22 of the Interpretation Ordinance, the Administrator has been pleased to depute the Chief Officer to exercise the powers set out in the second column of the Schedule hereto, which are conferred upon the Administrator under the provisions of the Mines and Quarries (Regulation) Ordinance, set out in the first column of the said Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Provisions of Ordinance— Section	Description of powers
39	Power to grant quarry licences and fixing of period subject to such covenants, terms and conditions and in respect of such areas and subject to the payment of such rentals and fees as may, from time to time, be determined by the Administrator.
41	Power of Administrator to determine quarry licence in case of a continued breach on the part of the holder of a quarry licence of any of the covenants, terms or conditions therein contained.

(REGULATION AND CONTROL) ORDINANCE

(Ordinances 11 of 1962, 9 of 1963,
3 of 1967 and 10 of 1972).

CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER
MADE UNDER SECTIONS 3(1) AND 4(1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Maximum Price of Bread) Order, 1980.

2. In this Order —

“bread” means the product produced by baking flour unmixed with any substance other than water, salt and yeast or other leaven and which is of the type known as “psomi” or “ekmek”.

3. Bread is hereby declared to be a controlled commodity to be controlled and regulated under the provisions of the Ordinance.

4. The maximum price at which bread may be sold or offered for sale in the Areas shall not exceed ninety five (95) mils for each kilo.

5. Public Instruments Nos. 4 of 1977 and 76 of 1979 are hereby revoked.

CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER
MADE UNDER SECTIONS 3(1) AND 4(1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Soft Drinks) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1980 and shall be read as one with the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Soft Drinks) Order, 1975 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by deleting the Schedule thereto and substituting therefor the following new Schedule :—
