This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurers) (Consolidation) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1980 and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurers) (Consolidation) Order, 1980 as amended by the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurers) (Consolidation) (Amendment) Order, 1980 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Order”).

2. Paragraph 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended by including:—

(a) as item “12A”, immediately after item 12, the following new insurance company:—

“12A. Eagle Star Insurance Company Limited”.

(b) as item “28A”, immediately after item 28, the following new insurance company:—

“28A. Reliance Insurance Company Limited”.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Soft Drinks) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order, 1980 and shall be read as one with the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Soft Drinks) Order, 1975 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Order”).

CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER  
MADE UNDER SECTIONS 3(1) AND 4(1).

---

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Maximum Price of Bread) Order, 1980.

2. In this Order —

“bread” means the product produced by baking flour unmixed with any substance other than water, salt and yeast or other leaven and which is of the type known as “psomi” or “ekmek”.

3. Bread is hereby declared to be a controlled commodity to be controlled and regulated under the provisions of the Ordinance.

4. The maximum price at which bread may be sold or offered for sale in the Areas shall not exceed one hundred (100) mils for each kilo.

5. Public Instrument No. 36 of 1980 is hereby revoked.
