THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 7.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Chief Officer under Section 7 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974, I, the Acting Chief Officer, hereby order that the shooting of game and wild birds shall during the game season take place only between sunrise and sunset :

Provided that duck may be shot between sunset and sunrise in the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area.

**THE COMMODITIES AND SERVICES
(REGULATION AND CONTROL) ORDINANCE**

(Ordinances 11 of 1962, 9 of 1963, 3 of 1967 and 10 of 1972).

**CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER
MADE UNDER SECTIONS 3(1) AND 4(1).**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Local Cheese) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1981 and shall be read as one with the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Local Cheese) Order, 1976 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Order”).

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by deleting the Schedule thereto and substituting therefor the following new Schedule :—

**THE COMMODITIES AND SERVICES
(REGULATION AND CONTROL) ORDINANCE**

(Ordinances 11 of 1962, 9 of 1963, 3 of 1967 and 10 of 1972).

**CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER
MADE UNDER SECTIONS 3(1) AND 4(1).**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Gas) Order, 1981.

2. Gas is hereby declared to be a controlled commodity for the purpose of the Ordinance.

3. The wholesale and retail prices at which gas may be sold or offered for sale in the Areas shall not exceed the maximum prices set out in the second and third columns respectively of the Schedule thereto.

Gas	£1.455 mils per ten (10) kilo cylinder (plus 145.5 mils per each additional kilo).	£1.525 mils per ten (10) kilo cylinder (plus 152.5 mils per each additional kilo)”.

THE PRISONS ORDINANCE, 1971

(Ordinance 11 of 1971).

THE POLICE ORDINANCE, 1967

(Ordinances 9 of 1967, 14 of 1969 and 7 of 1975).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 15
OF THE PRISONS ORDINANCE, 1971, READ WITH SECTION 9
OF THE POLICE ORDINANCE, 1967, AND SECTION 12 OF
THE PRISONS ORDINANCE.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Chief Police Officer and Superintendent of Prisons by subsection (2) of Section 15 of the Prisons Ordinance, 1971, read with Section 9 of the Police Ordinance, 1967, and Section 12 of the Prisons Ordinance, I, the Acting Chief Police Officer and Superintendent of Prisons, with the approval of the Administrator, hereby make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police and Prison Officers (General) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1981, and shall, where they apply to the Police (General) Regulations, 1967, as amended from time to time, hereinafter referred to as “the principal Police Regulations”, be read as one with those Regulations, and where they apply to the Police (General) Regulations, 1967, as modified by paragraph 2 and Appendix II of Public Instrument No. 60 of 1971 and thereby made applicable to, and made to relate to, the service of prison officers, be read as one with such Regulations as so modified, which are hereinafter referred to as “the principal Prison Officers Regulations.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Police Regulations and the principal Prison Officers Regulations is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph :—

P. Is. Nos.
42/79 and 85/79.

“The above salary scales are increased as follows :

- (a) from 1st January, 1981 to 31st December, 1981, both dates inclusive, three and a half per centum (3.5%) subject to a minimum increase of £ 36 per annum;
- (b) from 1st January, 1982 to 30th November, 1982, both dates inclusive, a total increase of seven and a half per centum (7.5%) shall be added to basic salaries as

they have been increased by virtue of paragraph (a) above, namely, it includes the increase of three and a half (3.5%) stipulated in paragraph (a) above, subject to a total minimum increase of £77 per annum, namely it includes the minimum increase of £36 per annum stipulated in paragraph (a) above ;

- (c) from 1st December, 1982 a total increase of ten per centum (10%), namely it includes the increase of seven and a half (7.5%) stipulated in paragraph (b) above, subject to a total minimum increase of £103 per annum, namely it includes the minimum increase of £77 per annum stipulated in paragraph (b) above.”.
