THE BETTING HOUSES, GAMING HOUSES AND GAMBLING PREVENTION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 151 — Laws of Cyprus and Ordinances 7 of 1965 and 2 of 1978).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 17.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 17 of the Betting Houses, Gaming Houses and Gambling Prevention Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Amusement Machines (Registration and Licensing) (Amendment) Regulations, 1981 and shall be read as one with the Amusement Machines (Registration and Licensing) Regulations, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations.").

2. Regulation 9 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the figure "18" appearing in paragraph (b) thereof and substituting therefor the figure "16".

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS (PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 30.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 30 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974, I hereby declare the whole of Dhekelia Sovereign Base Area (other than the area already declared as a Game Reserve under Public Instrument No. 58 of 1969) to be a temporary Game Reserve for the period beginning on 1st January, 1982 and ending on 31st December, 1982.

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS (PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE

(Ordinance 11 of 1974).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27(1)(b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of Section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue winter migrants and other wild birds, including such vermin as sparrows, crows, magpies, jackdaws and foxes, in the area set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 12th December, 1981 and ending on the 31st March 1982, subject to the following terms and conditions :-

- (a) shooting shall take place between sunrise and sunset only, provided that duck may be shot during the hours of darkness;
- (b) there shall be no shooting within 200 yards of any Service installations or within 100 yards of the perimeter of the RAF Station Akrotiri;
- (c) no fires shall be kindled;
- (d) there shall be no shooting within 300 yards of Akrotiri village built-up area or in any private fenced up land;
- (e) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered;
- (f) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun.

S C H E D U L E

All that area in the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area which lies south of boundary pillars 266 to 242; thence in a westerly direction along the boundary of the Akrotiri Main State Forest up to forest cairn 17 and thence in a straight line due west as far as the coast, with the exception of any game reserves which lie within the said area.
