THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinances 11 of 1974 and 1 of 1982).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTIONS 2 AND 26.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Sections 2 and 26 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974 the Administrator has prescribed that the periods specified in the Schedule hereto shall be a close season in addition to the close season as defined in Section 2 of the Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

- (a) the period between 1st October, 1982 and 13th November, 1982, both days inclusive.
 - (b) The 27th, 28th, 29th, 30th and 31st December, 1982.
 - (c) All days in the week during a non-close season except Wednesdays and Sundays.

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinances 11 of 1974 and 1 of 1982).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 6 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974, I, the Chief Officer, hereby order as follows :—

1. This order may be cited as the Game (Ceiling) Order, 1982.
2. The number of game that may be shot or possessed by the holder of a game licence on any day shall not exceed five partridges, or four partridges and one francolin.
