THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinances 11 of 1974 and 1 of 1982).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of Section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue turtle-doves, wood pigeons, rock-pigeons, quail, bee-eaters and curlews, including such vermin as sparrows, crows, magpies, jackdaws and foxes, in the areas set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 14th August 1983 and ending on the 30th September 1983, subject to the following terms and conditions :—

- (a) shooting shall take place between sunrise and sunset only ;
- (b) there shall be no shooting within 200 yards of any service installations or within 100 yards of the perimeter of the RAF Station Akrotiri ;
- (c) no fires shall be kindled ;
- (d) there shall be no shooting within 200 yards of any village built-up area or in any private fenced up land ;
- (e) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered ;
- (f) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun.

SCHEDULE

AREA 'A'

All that area in the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area which lies south of boundary pillars 266 to 242; thence in a westerly direction along the boundary of the Akrotiri Main State Forest up to the Upper Marsh ('Pano Livadhi') tarmac road; thence along that road as far as its junction with an earth road and thence in a straight line due west as far as the coast, other than any game reserves which lie within the said area.

AREA 'B'

All that area which lies west of the Kouris river up to Curium beach track bounded on the north by the M. 1 road, plus a coastal area on the east bank of the river as indicated on the ground by sign posts.

AREA 'C'

All that area which lies south of Limassol-Ypsonas road, commencing from boundary pillar 188 and ending at boundary pillar 146; thence the boundary runs due south along the SBA boundaries up to the junction of the Trakhoni - Kolossi link road on the main Phassouri - Kolossi road; thence along the former road up to boundary pillar 201, excluding any game reserves and certain lands which lie between the two main earth tracks which branch off the old Kolossi-Zakaki road and converge on a track south of the Ypsonas - Kolossi main road, the area banned for shooting in this particular pocket of lands having been properly sign posted on the ground.

THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 226 — Laws of Cyprus —
and Ordinances 12 of 1963 and 9 of 1964).

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas by Public Instrument No. 32 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette No. 653 of the 4th May, 1983, the Administrator declared the provision of additional public roads and the widening of certain existing streets within Akrotiri village to be an undertaking of public utility;

And whereas the Area Officer Akrotiri, in compliance with subsection (1) of Section 6 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, by Public Instrument No. 33 of 1983, gave particulars of the land required in connection with the said undertaking of public utility (hereinafter referred to as "the property");

And whereas the Area Officer Akrotiri, in compliance with subsection (2) of the said section, forwarded to the Administrator the required recommendations, plans and particulars together with one objection made thereto;

And whereas, having considered the said objection, the Administrator has approved the plan and particulars submitted and has considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the property be acquired;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 7 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, the Administrator hereby sanctions the acquisition of the property under the provisions of the said Ordinance.

THE INDUSTRIAL TRAINING AUTHORITY
(REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS) (RECOGNITION)
ORDINANCE, 1979

(Ordinances 1 of 1979 and 20 of 1980).

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR
UNDER SECTIONS 9 AND 15.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Sections 9 and 15 of the Industrial Training Authority (Republic of Cyprus) (Recognition) Ordinance, 1979 the Administrator hereby makes the following regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Industrial Training Authority (Employers' Levy) (Amendment) Regulations, 1983 and shall be read as one with the Industrial Training Authority (Employers' Levy) Regulations, 1979 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

P. Is. Nos. 39/79,
87/79 and 102/80.

2. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the first proviso to paragraph (1) thereof and substituting therefor the following new proviso :

“Provided that no levy shall be payable in respect of any part of wages exceeding one hundred and eighteen pounds weekly or five hundred and ten pounds monthly :”.

3. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 4th July, 1983.
