THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinances 11 of 1974 and 1 of 1982).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTIONS 2 AND 26.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Sections 2 and 26 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974 the Administrator has prescribed that the periods specified in the Schedule hereto shall be a close season in addition to the close season as defined in Section 2 of the Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

- (a) the period between 1st October, 1984 and 10th November, 1984, both days inclusive, as well as the 31st December, 1984.
- (b) All days in the week during a non-close season except Wednesdays and Sundays.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 6 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974, I, the Chief Officer, hereby order as follows :—

1. This order may be cited as the Game (Ceiling) Order, 1984.
2. The number of partridges that may be shot or possessed by the holder of a game licence on any day shall not exceed five.

(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinances 11 of 1974 and 1 of 1982).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 10.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of Section 10 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby prohibits the shooting, killing, taking, pursuing or selling of francolin during the 1984 game season as prescribed in Public Instrument No. 47 of 1984.
