## THE PUBLIC WATERWORKS ORDINANCE

(Cap. 341 — Laws of Cyprus and Ordinance 4 of 1969).

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTIONS 4A AND 29.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him under Sections 4A and 29 of the Public Waterworks Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Polemidhia (Garyllis) and Yermasoyia Public Waterworks Regulations and Management) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1984 and shall be read as one with the Polemidhia (Garyllis) and Yermasoyia Public Waterworks (Regulation and Management) Regulations, 1976 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").
- 2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by deleting Regulation 4 thereof and substituting therefor the following new Regulation:—
  - "4. The following rates shall be payable by every proprietor for water supplied or used by him:—
    - (a) 3½ cents for each cubic meter or water supplied or used from Polemidhia (Garyllis) and Yermasoyia waterworks;
    - (b) ½ cent for each cubic meter of water supplied or used from the overflow of the dams:

Provided that, where a proprietor has for the requirements of his land as recorded in the specification made use of a quantity of water which is less than one quarter of the quantity shown against his name in the specification, he shall pay an amount not exceeding £2 annually for each donum of his land for which water has not been so used, unless the Committee decides that the said quantity of water has not been used for reasons strictly beyond the control of the proprietor.".
