THE INDUSTRIAL TRAINING AUTHORITY
(REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS) (RECOGNITION)
ORDINANCE, 1979

(Ordinances 1 of 1979 and 20 of 1980).

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR
UNDER SECTIONS 9 AND 15.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Sections 9 and 15 of the Industrial Training Authority (Republic of Cyprus) (Recognition) Ordinance, 1979 the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Industrial Training Authority (Employers' Levy) (Amendment) Regulations, 1985 and shall be read as one with the Industrial Training Authority (Employers' Levy) Regulations, 1979 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the first proviso to paragraph (1) thereof and substituting therefor the following new proviso:—

"Provided that no levy shall be payable in respect of any part of wages exceeding one hundred and forty seven pounds weekly or six hundred and thirty seven pounds monthly."

3. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 1st day of April, 1985.

THE WATER SUPPLY (SPECIAL MEASURES)
ORDINANCE, 1964

(Ordinances 14 of 1964, 8 of 1965 and 6 of 1975).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in him under Section 9 of the Water Supply (Special Measures) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Water Supply (Special Measures) (Amendment) Regulations, 1985 and shall be read as one with the Water Supply (Special Measures) Regulations, 1966 as amended by the Water Supply (Special Measures) (Amendment) Regulations, 1976 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Regulation 6 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the words "two hundred and fifty mils" appearing in the second line thereof and substituting therefor the words "three pounds".

THE SEA BATHERS (PROTECTION) ORDINANCE, 1968
(Ordinance 16 of 1968).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Section 3 of the Sea Bathers (Protection) Ordinance, 1968, I, the Chief Officer, hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Bathers (Protection) Order, 1985.

2. The areas specified in the Schedules hereto (hereinafter referred to as "reserved areas") are reserved exclusively for persons bathing in the sea, subject to the conditions and restrictions set out in the said Schedules in respect of each area :

Provided that the restrictions relating to the sailing of boats within the reserved areas shall only have effect between sunrise and sunset.

3. The reserved areas shall be demarcated by buoys.

4. This Order shall become operative on the 10th day of May 1985, and shall :

(a) In respect of the areas specified in the First Schedule hereto, cease to have effect on the 31st day of October, 1985.

(b) In respect of the area specified in the Second Schedule hereto, continue in force until revoked.

FIRST SCHEDULE

SOVEREIGN BASE AREA AKROTIRI

1. All map references in paragraph 2 of this Schedule refer to 1:50,000 scale map, Sheet 23, series K717, edition 3-GSGS.

2.—(1) The reserved areas are the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas extending seawards 100 yards unless otherwise stated from the following stretches of shore :

(a) **Evdhimou Beach (West).**

78303528 to 78613530.

(b) **Evdhimou Beach (East).**

78803528 to 79173518 :

Provided that the area shall be bounded on the western side by a line running south-east from 78803528.

(c) **Paramali Beach.**

82103566 to 82403565.

(d) Happy Valley Beach Episkopi.

83253582 to 83503574.

(e) Tunnel Beach Episkopi.

84413629 to 84653623.

(f) Curium Beach.

88553627 to 89343565.

(g) Royal Air Force Station Akrotiri (South).

03272534 to 03032559.

(h) Royal Air Force Station Akrotiri (North).

02822600 (extending 100 yards seawards) to 02612620 (extending seawards to a point under map reference 02802622).

02432666 to 01402770.

01402770 to 01002807 (extending 50 yards seawards throughout).

(i) Ladies Mile Beach.

00822820 to 01113363 :

Provided that motor launches and sailing vessels may enter the said area through three sea lanes each of an approximate width of 100 yards and each marked with buoys, and that a fourth sea lane of an approximate width of 100 yards and marked with buoys shall be reserved for sail and wind surf boards only :

Provided further that the foreshore under item (i) of this subparagraph shall include land within a distance from high water mark not exceeding 10 yards.

(2) Copies of the map referred to above are properly marked and deposited at the Area Office of the Sovereign Base Areas Administration Akrotiri for inspection by any interested person.

SOVEREIGN BASE AREA DHEKELIA**1. Officers' Club Beach.**

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 67887120 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 7-GSGS, to a point westwards under map reference 67457116 ; thence northwards to a point on the headland under map reference 67457122.

2. CESSAC (Church of England Soldiers', Sailors', Airmen's Club) Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 67187143 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 7-GSGS, then to a point under map reference 67157143 and then to a point southwest under map reference 67067132, then to a point on the coast under map reference 66737129.

3. St. George's Club Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 66377120 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 7-GSGS to a point westwards on the headland under map reference 66127123.

4. Victor Beach Club (Off Alexander Barracks).

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the shore under map reference 65477129 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 7-GSGS to a point southwards under map reference 65407115 ; thence westwards in a straight line to a point under map reference 65297115 ; thence northwards to the shore to a point under map reference 65297128.

5. Fairwinds Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the shore under map reference 643711 of Sheet 21, series K717, edition 2-GSGS to a point southwards under map reference 643710 ; thence westwards in a straight line to a point under map reference 641710 ; thence northwards to the shore to a point under map reference 641711 ; all of which area stretches for 300 yards along the coast and at a distance of 100 yards from high water mark.

Copies of the maps referred to above are properly marked and deposited at the Area Office of the Sovereign Base Areas Administration Dhekelia for inspection by any interested person.

SECOND SCHEDULE

SOVEREIGN BASE AREA AKROTIRI

Royal Air Force Station Akrotiri (North).

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the point on the shore under map reference 02562635 of sheet 23, series K717, edition 3-GSGS, to a point under map reference 02682649 ; thence to a point under map reference 02802622 ; thence to the point on the shore under map reference 02612620.

Copies of the map referred to above are properly marked and deposited at the Area Office of the Sovereign Base Areas Administration Akrotiri for inspection by any interested person.

**THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974**

(Ordinances 11 of 1974 and 1 of 1982).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of Section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974 the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue turtle-doves, wood-pigeons, rock-pigeons, sparrows, crows, magpies and foxes, in the areas set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 21st April, 1985 and ending on the 12th May, 1985 subject to the following terms and conditions:—

- (a) shooting shall take place between sunrise and sunset only ;
- (b) there shall be no shooting within 200 yards of any Service installations or within 100 yards of the perimeter of the RAF Station Akrotiri ;
- (c) no fires shall be kindled ;
- (d) there shall be no shooting within 200 yards of any village built-up area or in any private fenced up land ;
- (e) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered ;
- (f) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun ;
- (g) no dogs shall be allowed.

SCHEDULE

AREA 'A'

All that area in the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area which lies south of boundary pillars 266 to 242 ; thence in a westerly direction along the boundary of the Akrotiri Main State Forest until the main road ; thence in a southerly direction along that road, until the southern junction of the Upper Marsh road and thence in a westerly direction along that road and track upto the coast.

AREA 'B'

All that area which lies west of the Kouris river up to Curium beach track bounded on the north by the M.1 road, plus an area in the form of a triangle to the east of Kouris river, bounded on one side by the river, on another by the coast and on the third side by the track which demarcates the Game Reserve Area (Ayios Demetrianos locality).

AREA 'C'

All that area which lies south of Limassol - Ypsonas road, commencing from boundary pillar 188 and ending at boundary pillar 146; thence the boundary runs due south along the Sovereign Base Area boundaries up to the junction of the Trakhoni - Kolossi link road on the main Phassouri - Kolossi road; thence along the former road up to boundary pillar 201, excluding any game reserves and certain lands which lie between the two main earth tracks which branch off the old Kolossi-Zakaki road and converge on a track south of the Ypsonas - Kolossi main road, the area banned for shooting in this particular pocket of lands having been properly signposted on the ground.
